

# **CAL/OSHA PENALTIES**

Cal/OSHA penalties for violation of safety standards and orders vary based on the likelihood of causing serious injury to employees. Citations can carry penalties of up to \$7,000 for regulatory or general violations and up to \$25,000 for each serious violation. Additional penalties of up to \$7,000 per day for regulatory or general violations and up to \$15,000 per day for serious violations may be proposed for each failure to correct a violation by the abatement date shown on the citation.

## **REGULATORY VIOLATIONS**

Civil penalties for regulatory violations are proposed based on the following:

- Failure to report a serious injury or illness: \$5,000
- Failure to report carcinogen use: \$2,500 for each carcinogen
- Carcinogen, other than reporting: \$1,000
- Failure of a physician to report a pesticide-relate illness: \$250
- Failure to conform to asbestos-related registration requirements: \$1,250
- Failure to obtain a construction activity permit: \$1,250
- Any other non-carcinogen or non-pesticide related illness: \$500

### **GENERAL VIOLATIONS**

Civil penalties for general violations are proposed based on the severity, extent and likelihood of the violation. Penalties for general violations are based on the following:

Severity Extent Likelihood

Low: \$1,000 Low: -25% of severity Low: -25% of severity

Medium: \$1,500 Medium: 0 Medium: 0

High: \$2,000 High: +25% of severity High: +25% of severity

### SERIOUS VIOLATIONS

Civil penalties for serious violations are proposed based on the severity, extent and likelihood of the violation. Penalties for serious violations are based on the following:

Severity Extent Likelihood

Serious: \$18,000 Low: -25% of severity Low: -25% of severity

(non-carcinogen) Medium: 0 Medium: 0

Serious: \$2,000 High: +25% of severity High: +25% of severity

(carcinogen)

*Note:* In determining the gravity-based penalty for a serious (non-carcinogen) violation that Cal/OSHA determines caused a death of a serious injury, illness or exposure, the adjustments to the severity-based penalty for extent and likelihood shall only be rated as moderate or high and in <u>no</u> case shall the gravity-based penalty be <u>less than \$18,000</u>.
