

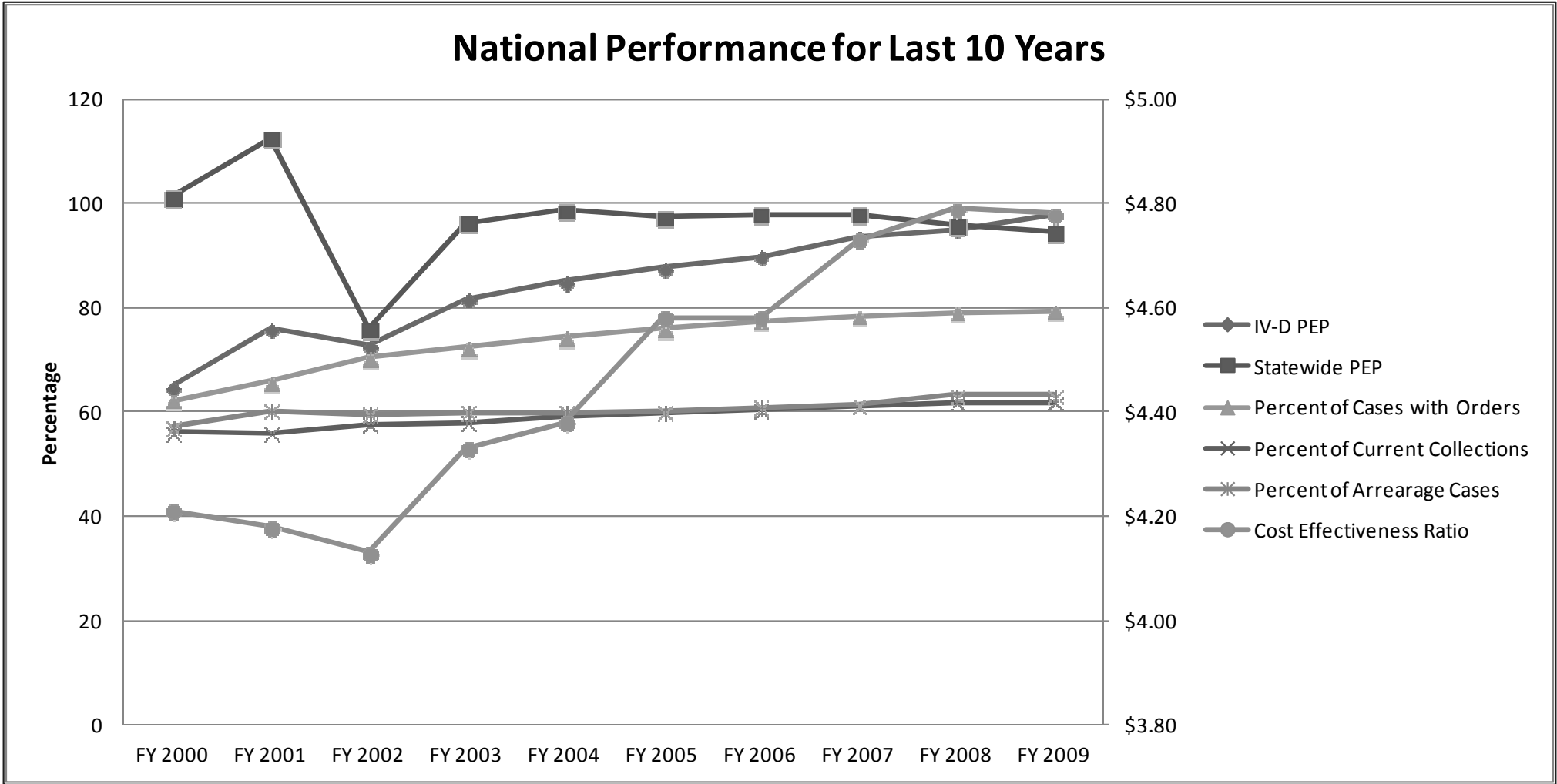

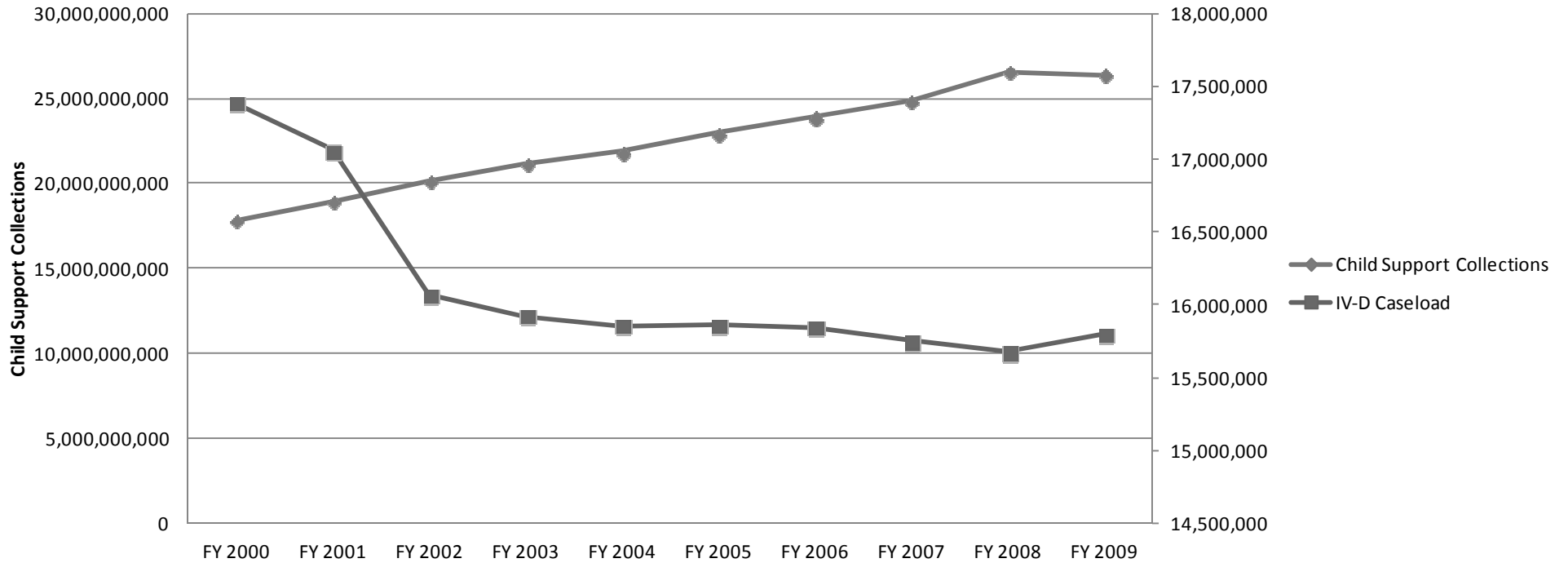
Child Support Performance on 5 measures

Collections and IV-D Caseloads

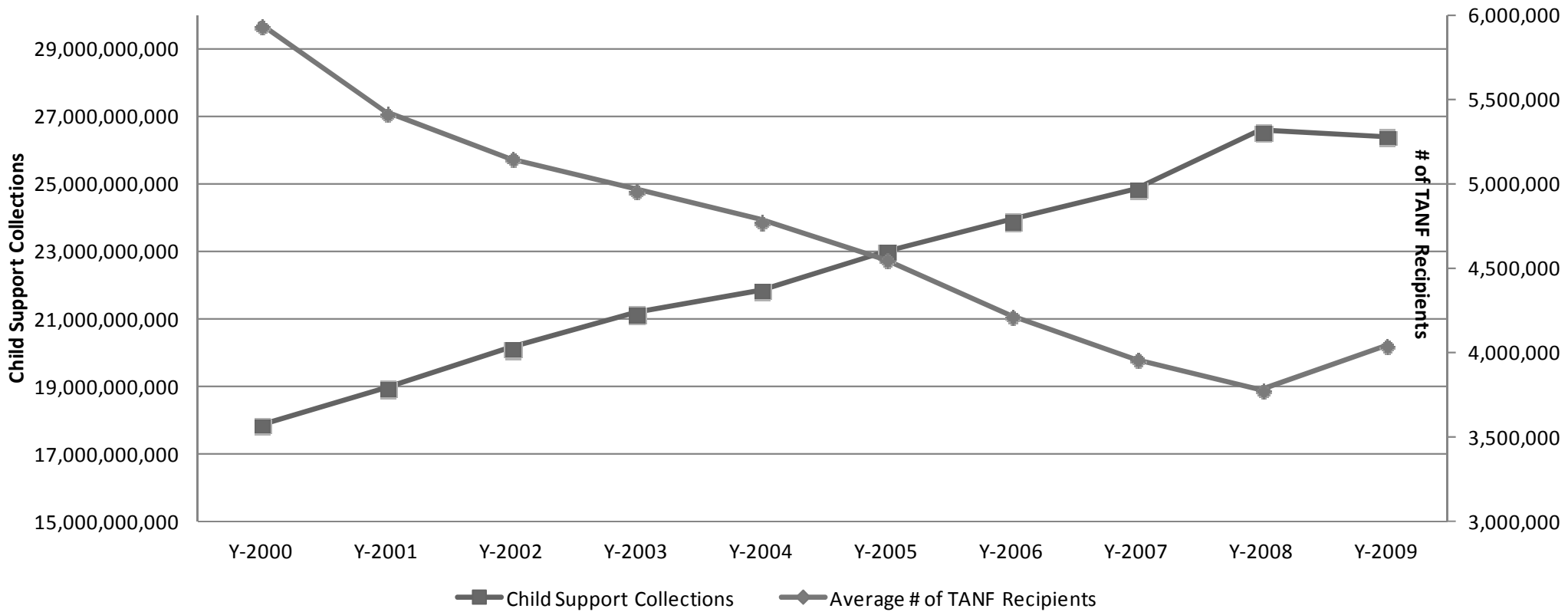
Child Support Collections and IV-D Caseloads for Last 10 Years

Potential Outcome Measures for Supporting Programs

- Behavior desired:
 - Job (1 month, 3 months, 6 months; Wage increase)
 - Paternity Established
 - Family relationship (time with children, reduction in conflict)
 - Child Support Payments (amount, longevity)

- Higher Level Outcomes
 - TANF caseload reduction
 - Less time on TANF
 - Overall Family income increase

- Cost Effectiveness
 - Cost less than Collections
