

ROOSTER INFORMATION

The County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors is considering limiting the number of roosters kept by individuals in the unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County. Many cities in Los Angeles County already prohibit or limit the number of roosters allowed. Several counties in California have or are enacting similar ordinances.

As part of the review process, the Department of Animal Care and Control invites comments from the public. The Department will be holding community forums that residents are encouraged to attend.
