

# ATTENTION HULL CLEANERS AND INTERESTED BOATERS

## NEW HULL CLEANING REGULATIONS FOR MARINA DEL REY HARBOR, EFFECTIVE JULY 2018

Los Angeles County passed new regulations that require all persons who perform hull cleaning in Marina del Rey Harbor to receive certification in hull cleaning Best Management Practices (BMPs). The new regulations also prohibit hull cleaning that result in the creation of a visible paint plume in the water. *The purpose of these regulations is to protect our harbor waters from copper pollution released during hull cleaning.*

### IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE REGULATIONS:

- (1) Complete a Hull Cleaning BMP Training and obtain proof of certification.
- (2) Update Your Commercial Service ID. Submit proof of BMP training completion to the Harbor Master at the LA County Sheriff Department, 13851 Fiji Way, Marina del Rey or call (310) 482-6000 to receive a certification mark on your Commercial Service ID.

In order to help the Marina del Rey boating community to comply with the new regulations, the County is hosting a hull cleaning BMP training workshop that is free and open to the public. Attendees who complete the training will receive a certificate of completion.
