## FREE MARINA DEL REY SUMMER CONCERTS KICK OFF TENTH ANNIVERSARY SEASON THURSDAY, JULY 8

MARINA DEL REY, Calif. – May 27, 2010 - The tenth anniversary season of the Marina del Rey Summer Concerts promises to be one of the most entertaining in its history of widely varied and exciting presentations. As always, concerts are presented free to the public. Classical Thursdays, featuring the 75-member Marina del Rey Summer Symphony conducted by its musical director Frank Fetta, kicks off the season July 8. Pop Saturdays, beginning July 17, will present four of the most popular star attractions in the series' history. Popular KUSC personality Rich Capparela is series host.

Held waterside in beautiful Burton Chace Park, Marina del Rey, all concerts begin at 7 pm to permit audiences to view the sunset while they enjoy the music.

"A Night at the Opera" starts off the season on July 8, presenting finalists and winners of the Loren L. Zachary National Vocal Competition, one of the world's premiere competitions for singers. Featured will be soprano Narine Ojakhyan from Glendale; and soprano Wendy Bryn Harmer, bass-baritone Donovan Singletary, and tenor Matthew Plenk, already appearing with the Metropolitan Opera.

July 22 will feature an unforgettable young American pianist, 19-year-old Claire Huangci, called by critics "one of the century's major talents."

August 5 will present a unique program of symphonic Beatles musical arrangements, featuring The Christopher Brothers, singing and playing Beatles' songs and joining the orchestra in its symphonic tribute. Also on the program are symphonic works by George Gershwin and John Dankworth.

composer and arranger to an evening with "Oscar Castro-Neves and Friends."

Closing the season on August 28 will be the return of that great lady of jazz,

Dame Cleo Laine who will be joined by her ensemble and her daughter, British jazz

favorite Jacqui Dankworth, in an evening of memorable renditions of classics from jazz

to Broadway.
