SUPERVISORS APPROVE MARINA DEL REY ODOR CONTROL PROJECT

MARINA DEL REY, CALIF. - July 20, 2010 - Beaches and Harbors announced today

the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors approved plans and specifications and

advertisement for a construction bid contract to construct a sanitary sewer air scrubber in

Marina del Rey.

The Odor Control project will help deal with the odor issue along Admiralty Way in front

of the Marina City Club, which is part of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works

ongoing program for the operation, maintenance and repair of sewer systems.

All traffic lanes on Admiralty Way will be open prior to 8:30 a.m. and after 3:30 p.m.

Eastbound traffic lanes shall remain open at all times. Between those hours, traffic in the

westerly direction may be reduced to one lane and a left-turn lane where existing.

The project will be completed in approximately 20 working days and has an estimated

cost between \$145,000 and \$170,000, which is included in the Fiscal Year 2010-11 Marina del

Rey Sewer Maintenance District Fund Budget.

Work on the Odor Control project is anticipated to start in October 2010 and is

scheduled to be completed November 2010.
