1. First, you need to find the serial number on your bike. It can be found in one of four areas on the frame.



2. Go to Nationalbikeregistry.com to fill out an NBR registration form or mail in the form below with the appropriate fees.



3. You can also register your bike and pay your fees at your local **bike retailer, library branch** or **police department**.



4. In 2-3 weeks your registration certificate and bike label will be mailed to you.



5. Don't forget your safety gear!



6. That's it, you're ready to hit the road.
