Do Not:

Be late.

Wear flip-flops, tank tops, miniskirts, shorts, or sunglasses.

(No hats, unless for religious purposes.)

Eat, drink, or chew gum in the courtroom.

Use slang or foul language, or interrupt the other party.

Talk or make noise while court is in session.



Do:

Turn off all electronic devices.

Always address the judge as "Your Honor."

Present your evidence in a clear and concise manner.

Bring at least two copies of your evidence.

Be courteous.
