EMS Update 2017 Notice

EMS Update 2017 training is scheduled to run from May 1st through July 31st.

This annual training is mandatory for all Los Angeles County certified MICNs and accredited Paramedics.

This year's Update includes: Provider Impression, Critical Decision Making, Shock/Hypotension, Psychiatric Crisis and Agitated Delirium, BRUE, Seizures, Stroke/CVA and Crush Injury/Crush Syndrome.

EMS Update 2017 will be available at base hospitals and provider agencies approved by the EMS Agency to conduct this training. Classes open to the public will be posted on the EMS Agency web page at EMS Continuing Education. Space is limited, so please contact the course coordinator in advance to schedule your attendance.

Personnel who do not obtain EMS Update 2017, by the July 31st deadline, will be unable to function as an MICN or Paramedic until verification of EMS Update 2017 completion is submitted to the EMS Agency. Suspensions will be effective August 21st, 2017.
