

**\* Flexible Northern Boundary**

When paramedic providers identify that CNT is heavily impacted, the flexible northern boundary of the service area allows patients to the west of the 405 Freeway to be transported to Marina Del Rey Hospital (DFM), to the extent that DFM can absorb additional traffic and accounting for their service capability. This does not open the northern boundary to traffic coming into the service area.
