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PURPOSE:

To maintain a smoke-free environment at the Los Angeles County College of Nursing and Allied Health (College) in accordance with LAC + USC Medical Center policy and as mandated by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors.

POLICY:

Smoking is not allowed anywhere within the LAC + USC Medical Center / College facilities and grounds.

Definition:

Smoking includes the smoking of pipe, cigar, cigarette, operating electronic cigarette, or any other like substance; lighting such substance, and/or carrying a burning pipe, cigar, cigarette, or like substance of any kind.

PROCEDURE:

"No smoking" signs shall be posted.

College employees and students are informed of the smoke-free environment policy during orientation.
