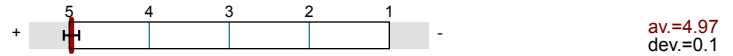

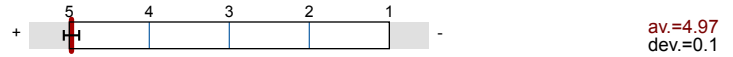

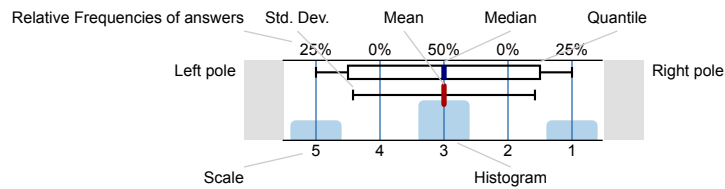

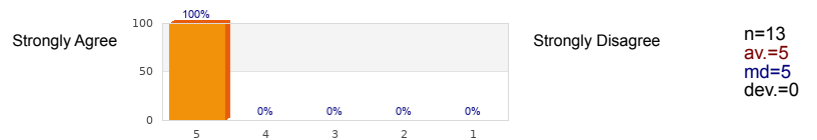

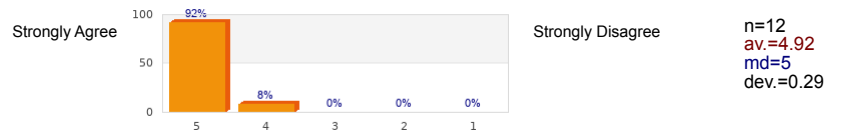

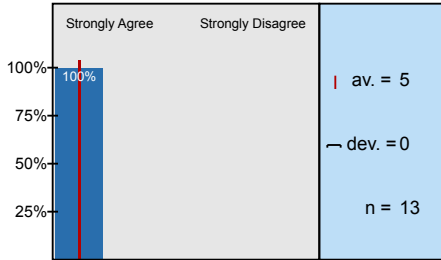

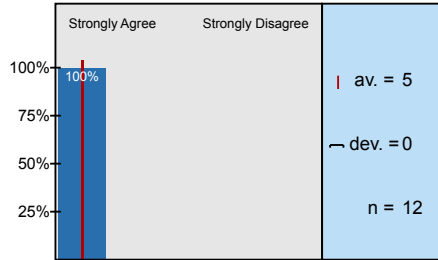


Histogram for scaled questions

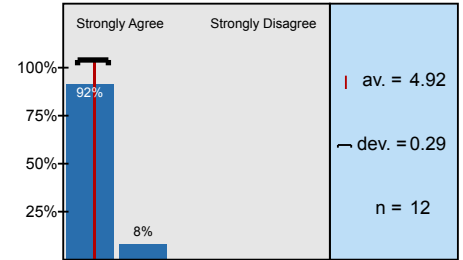
