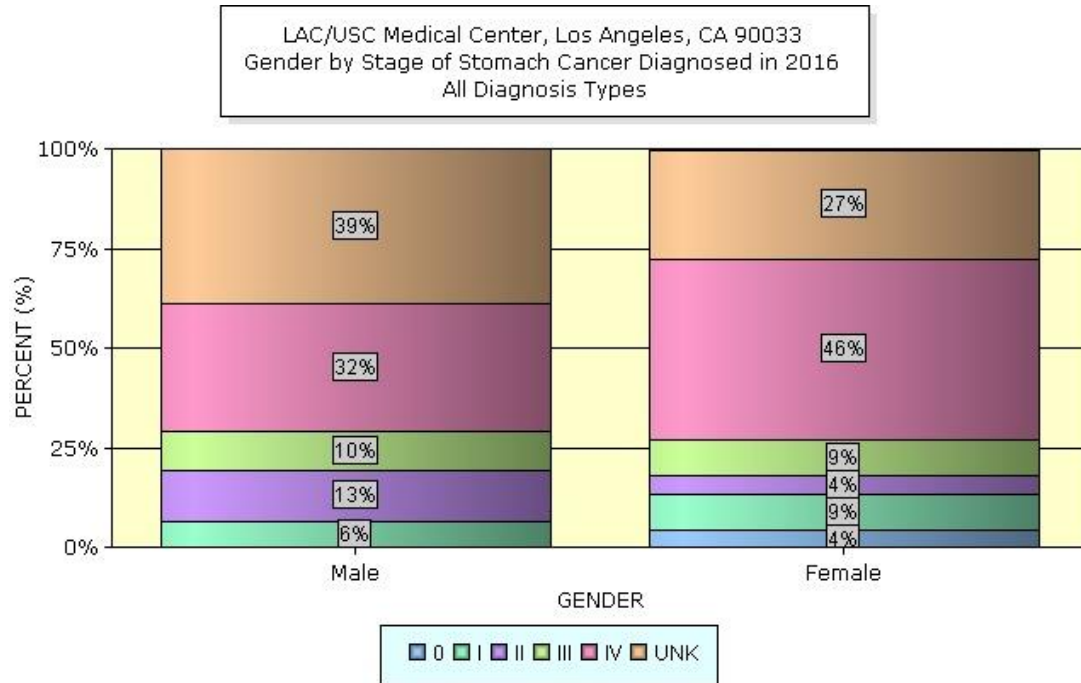


LAC+USC Medical Center Public Reporting of Outcomes

Treatment of Stomach Cancer at LAC+USC Medical Center



- 53 new stomach cancer cases were diagnosed in 2016
- 58% were male and 42% were female
- 15 of 53 cases presented at an early stage (Stage 0, I, II, or III)
- Standard of care for number of lymph nodes (LN) resected is at least 15 LN resected (NCCN V2.2018)
- The Commission on Cancer's (COC) standard is removal of at least 15 LN in 80% of cases
- LAC/USC Medical Center exceeded this requirement with 100% of patients having at least 15 LN removed
- LAC/USC continues to improve and exceed COC standards
- Because stomach cancer is curable with resection earlier detection of stomach cancer is important
