Position Information:

Harbor-UCLA Medical Center is seeking a Registered Nurse II (RN II) to provide follow-up and interventions to patients diagnosed with ostomies, draining wounds, fistulae, or skin breakdown secondary to pressure, incontinence and other related skin issues. The Wound Care Nurse will lead and coordinate the needs of vulnerable patients with complex medical conditions and reports to the Nurse Manager.

Responsibilities Include But Are Not Limited To The Following:

- > Act as lead resource/ consultant for wound care nurses, staff, and managers on wound prevention & management.
- > Serves as patient advocate and collaborates timely with staff and provider on wound progress and skin integrity issues.
- > Meets with regulatory compliance agencies as needed for complex cases.
- > Collaborates with Medical Administration on complex cases for staging of wounds.
- > Provides comprehensive wound management, including preventing and treating pressure ulcers, other wounds, ostomies and continence disorders.
- > Conducts ongoing assessments, reassessments and monitoring of wound progress and applies appropriate interventions.
- > Provides, selects and recommends appropriate wound care treatment and wound care products.
- > Educates new/frontline staff and patient/patients family on wound care management and skin care to prevent skin breakdown.
- > Delegates, assigns, and/or supervises as needed the assigned work of other Wound Care Team Nurses as needed.
- > Participates in patient care conferences, committee meetings and staff development.
- > Seeks experiences to enhance clinical practice, professional development and maintain competencies.
- > Participates in quarterly Collaborative Alliance for Nursing Outcomes (CALNOC) Hospital Acquired Pressure Injury (HAPI) Incidence study.
- > Other assignments as needed to meet the needs of the department.

Desirable Qualifications:

- > Passion, creativity, and positive approach to patient care and teamwork
- > Proficiency with ORCHID, Outlook, Word, Excel and PowerPoint
- > Maintains wound care certification from a nationally accredited agency

Candidates must currently hold a permanent County of Los Angeles payroll title of Registered Nurse II to be considered for a transfer or are reachable on a DHS certification list to be considered for a promotion or as a new hire.
