Position Information: LAC+USC Medical Center's Ambulatory Care Services is seeking a qualified Registered Nurse II for the Infusion Center. We are seeking highly motivated candidates who are interested in working in the ambulatory care setting. This position reports to a Supervising Staff Nurse I and/or Nurse Manager.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Interviews patient and other individuals to obtain complete health history including present illness, current health status and past medical, psychosocial, spiritual and, family histories. Considers patients' values and beliefs when providing care.
- Assesses, evaluates and documents, in an ongoing and systematic manner, the patients' physical, medical, and psychosocial circumstances.
- Identifies economic, cognitive or cultural barriers and determines their influence on the provision of care. Refers patients based on patients' needs and risk factors involved.
- Administers chemotherapeutic agents and other infusions as ordered.
- Participates in patient care conferences, committee meetings, staff development, and educational programs to increase or maintain professional competency.
- Implements the integrated plan of care and coordinates patient care activities with members of the interdisciplinary team.
- Coordinates delivery of patient care with other services and disciplines to achieve optimal patient outcomes.
- Serves as a preceptor to fellow nursing staff.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Effective interpersonal and organizational skills
- Effective critical thinking, decision making, and problem solving skills
- Recent experience working in a medicine/medical-surgical area with patients receiving chemotherapeutic agents
- Chemotherapy Certification
- Able to work efficiently with a diverse and challenging patient population
- Flexibility and willingness to adapt to various emergency situations and changes in assignment and schedule when necessary
