The LAC+USC Medical Center's Maternal Child and Adolescent Center (MCA) has position available for Registered Nurse III. We are seeking highly motivated candidates who are interested in working in the ambulatory care setting. This position reports to the Supervising Staff Nurse I and/or Nurse Manager.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Interviews patient and other individuals to obtain complete health history including present illness and current health status.
- Develops a plan of care based on the nursing process, while also collaborating with team members to provide the most effective treatment.
- Serves as a lead role in patient care conferences and staff development.
- Serves as a preceptor, mentoring staff to facilitate staffs' role development.
- Coordinates patient care using the nursing process, S.M.A.R.T goals, and a team-based approach.
- Develops, conducts, and implements quality care initiatives using evidence-based practice.
- Follows established policies and procedures within their scope of practice.
