Position Information: High Desert Regional Health Center and South Valley Health Center Urgent Care Clinics are seeking a qualified Registered Nurse II to assist in providing nursing services to a potentially critically ill group of adult and pediatric ambulatory care patients. This position reports to a Supervising Staff Nurse I and/or Nurse Manager.

Responsibilities Include But Are Not Limited To The Following:

- Serves as a team leader and preceptor.
- Conducts triage for unscreened, emergent/urgent walk-in patients.
- Provides direct patient care including patient assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of nursing care, treatment and interventions.
- Observes and monitors patients to assess risk of progressing to a higher acuity or emergent situation.
- Manages the movement of patients through the clinic to achieve an even and efficient flow.
- Recognizes the need for emergent orders and prioritize patient care needs based on acuity and urgency, in collaboration with all members of the healthcare team.
- Administers medications and intravenous fluids.
- Performs treatments as per provider orders.
- Documents proficiently in the Electronic Medical Record (ORCHID - FirstNet).
- Performs patient and family education related to disease process, medications, treatments and follow-up care.
- Be an example of a patient care advocate and make every attempt to resolve patient complaints within the clinic.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Recent direct patient care in Urgent Care or Emergency Room
- ACLS and PALS certified

Candidates must currently hold a permanent County of Los Angeles payroll title of Registered Nurse II to be considered for a transfer or are reachable on the DHS certification list to be considered for a promotion or as a new hire.
