The Registered Nurse I will report to a Supervising Clinic Nurse I and/or Nurse Manager.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Provides direct patient care, including patient assessment, planning, implementation, and evaluation of nursing care, treatment or intervention during critical care transports.
- Recognizes the need to prioritize patient care needs based on the acuity and urgency.
- Transports critical care patients to diagnostic and treatment areas and remains and monitors the patient until the procedure/treatment is completed.
- Serves as a professional role model and effective resource person for the team.
- Communicates collaboratively with patients, families, the interdisciplinary team and other nursing staff to ensure the highest quality of care, patient safety and customer satisfaction.
- Communicates with the medical provider of any change in patient's condition or if there are competing needs and priority to transport certain patients.

- Proficient in caring for critically ill patients
- Certification in Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
