POSITION INFORMATION: LAC+USC Medical Center Critical Care Transport has available positions for Registered Nurse II with Critical Care knowledge and skills in caring for critically ill patients. We are seeking highly motivated, innovative, enthusiastic nurses with critical thinking and great communication skills. The Registered Nurse II will report to Supervising Staff Nurse I and/or Nurse Manager.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Provides direct patient care, including patient assessment, planning, implementation, and evaluation of nursing care, treatment or intervention during critical care transport.
- Recognizes the need to prioritize patient care needs based on the acuity and urgency.
- Transports critical care patients to diagnostic and treatment areas and remains and monitors the patient until the procedure/treatment is completed.
- Supervises staff RNs and nursing attendants to ensure safe patient transports.
- Serves as a professional role model and effective resource person for the team.
- Communicates collaboratively with patients, families, the interdisciplinary team and other nursing staff to ensure the highest quality of care, patient safety and customer satisfaction.
- Communicates with the medical provider of any change in patient's condition or if there are competing needs and priority to transport certain patients.
- Evaluates the efficiency and timeliness of ICU patient transports to diagnostic/treatment areas.
- Orients, precepts and mentors new staff members.
- Delegate tasks effectively and appropriately.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum two years of strong critical care knowledge and experience
- Proficient in caring for critical care patients
- Certified in Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Self-motivated and good team player
- Strong organizational skills with the ability to prioritize
