Position Information: LAC+USC Medical Center Inpatient Jail Unit is currently seeking a highly qualified individual who is interested in working with the Nurse Educators, Nurse Manager and Nursing Director to develop, implement and coordinate the ongoing special educational projects/programs for the Jail units. This RN III will work with all levels of nursing staff to ensure appropriate patient care, staff training and/or educational development in all areas of Jail Units. This position reports to a Supervising Staff Nurse I.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Provides direct patient care including patient assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of nursing care, treatment or interventions.
- Provides educational in-services to nursing staff to ensure consistent development of newly hired registered nurses on all shifts – nights, evenings and day shift.
- Implements training and ongoing educational requirements to ensure continuous and comprehensive patient care through newly developed services and programs.
- Assists in overseeing the educational plan, preceptorship and mentorship for each new nurse graduating from the Emergency Department Nurse Training Program.
- Develops unit based training to improve knowledge base and competence in nursing staff working with adult, pediatric and psychiatric patients throughout the Department.
- Tracks educational compliance and gathers data for educator.
- Provides education to nurses and allied health personnel and acts as a resource to professional staff.
- Collects on-going data regarding outcomes of the Educational Program.
- Maintains current clinical knowledge, expertise and skills for the patient population and applies them through effective preceptor skills.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Minimum of five years of Adult/Jail/Psych Emergency Department experience
- Three years of teaching experience, including preceptorship of new nursing employees
- Proficient clinical skills, emergency knowledge base and experience as a clinical resource
- Ability to collaborate effectively in a dynamic and academic health care environment
- ACLS/PALS/NVPCI/DEM Training Program certifications required
- BSN/MSN/TNCC/MICN
