Treatment of patients with gastric cancer that are surgically resectable

- For patients with gastric cancer surgical resection is the standard of care along with resection of 15 lymph nodes (NCCN v3. 2019)
- The commission on cancer standard is 80% compliance
- LAC+USC Medical Center exceeded this standard in 2016 with compliance rate of 100%

Treatment of gastric cancer patients with unresectable disease

- Patients with metastatic cancer should have testing done for Her 2 neu amplification (NCCN v3. 2019)
- 100 percent of appropriate patients that had metastatic gastric cancer had their tumors tested for Her 2 neu amplification
- LAC+USC medical center continues to give state of the art care in unresectable gastric cancer

- Continued improvement in overall metrics
- Attention to documentation of HT
- EBL results suggest a high compliance rate in both evaluation and initial treatment of colon cancer
- Gastric Cancer evaluation and treatment meets compliance standards for both resectable and non-resectable cancer
