# 3.3 Rank Ordering of Proposals

After reviewing the project proposals listed above, the MBAB members will rank the proposals using a three-level ranking system.

- High priority (Score of 3)
- Medium priority (Score of 2)
- Low priority (Score of 1)

Since the meeting is being conducted on Zoom, the ranking will be done through a roll call process. The project being considered will be announced and then the MBAB members name will be called, and they will announce their numeric ranking of the project (3, 2 or 1).

After the meeting, all rankings will be totaled, and an average score will be determined using all voting member rankings for each proposal.

All MBAB members may vote on all proposals being considered, even if they are affiliated with the requesting entity, or has an interest in or will benefit from a proposal(s), unless it is deemed inappropriate by the MBAB Co-Chairs.
