

ODR Housing

A permanent supportive housing program that serves individuals who are homeless, have a serious mental health disorder, and are incarcerated in the Los Angeles County Jail. The intervention consists of pre-release jail in-reach services, enhanced treatment efforts, and immediate interim housing upon release from jail in anticipation of permanent supportive housing.
