JOB APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 6 months experience working with the public or community groups
- A valid CA driver's license OR the ability to utilize an alternative method of transportation
- Ability to work any shifter including evenings. nights, weekend and holidays
- Must be fully COVID-19 vaccinated

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Meet at *least one* of the following:

- Receiving CalWORKS, GR, or CalFresh
- Homeless or Housing Insecure
- Justice Involved
- Former Foster Youth (18 24 years old)
- Unemployed for 6 months or more

- Resume & Interview Prep Support
- Case Management
