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Dear BSN to NP Applicant:

Worker Education and Resource Center (WERC) in partnership with DHS and Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science is offering the Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) curriculum of study through a grant from the Department of Labor. **Due to a just-announced change in admission requirements, in order to be considered for admission to this program you must submit the following documentation in one complete packet by October 15, 2012**. This program is for nurses holding a baccalaureate degree in nursing (BSN). Upon completion graduates will be eligible to sit for the national certification exam through the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) or the American Academy of Nurse Practitioner (AANP). We anticipate the program to start in the Fall of 2012.

Application Requirements

- BSN degree from an accredited institution: Copy of BSN Diploma
- Copy of Post-Secondary Transcripts: One set of Official Transcripts and one set of Unofficial Transcripts from all colleges and universities attended. The unofficial transcript will be used to evaluate GPA and verify the BSN credential earned. Foreign Graduates: transcripts will have to be evaluated @ a your cost. - 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale)
- Copy of current California BRN RN license
- 3 letters of recommendation: Two of the three letters must be from a professional individual
 who can provide information about your academic ability. One of the three letters must be
 from your current supervisor validating five years of recent experience in the clinical setting
 within the last 10 years.
- Personal and professional goal statement: Goal statement should be no more than two
 pages. It must be written in your own words and should describe your commitment to the
 care of patients in LA County and how your goals are aligned with the mission of DHS.
- Copies of P.E. and attendance for the last three years: P.E. must be good to very good and must not have any disciplinary actions within the last three years
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Applicable Admission Fees NOT DUE AT THIS TIME
