POSITION: LAC+USC Medical Center's Ambulatory Care Services has positions available for Clinic Licensed Vocational Nurse I or Licensed Vocational Nurse I (CLVNI/LVN I) in its Violence Intervention Program. We are seeking highly motivated candidates who are interested in working in the ambulatory care setting.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Administers medications by injection, orally and other predetermined methods. Checks prescribed dosages, and observe and reports adverse reaction to medication.
- Sets up, operates and monitors electronic and/or mechanical equipment such as oxygen therapy, cardiac monitors, ECG and suctioning equipment.
- Collects patient data in a continuing manner and collaborates with other health care team members in contributing to plans of care based on findings.
- Appropriately dispositions patients and provides patient education, including discharge/follow-up instructions.
- Performs work with integrity and in compliance with professional nursing practice standards, policies and procedures, respecting patients' privacy and confidentiality

- One year recent experience working with Pediatric and Adolescent Patients
