POSITION: LAC+USC Medical Center's Division of Allergy and Immunology is seeking a highly motivated RNI with Pediatric and/or allergy or immunology experience to provide RN services to patients served by the Breathmobile Unit & hospital based clinic. Candidates with experience in pediatric asthma care and management are preferred. The RN I will provide asthma care and education to patients diagnosed with asthma and allergies as part of the Pediatric Asthma Disease Management Program. Pediatric and adult patients are served at school sites and Comprehensive Health Centers through the mobile "Breathmobile" program; adult and pediatric patients are served at the Allergy/Immunology Clinic at LAC+USC.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Driving the Breathmobile Unit (Clinic on wheels). Location of assignment includes both the Breathmobile and Allergy Clinic
- Provides direct patient care with the competencies and expertise expected at the level of the RN I position
- Demonstrates roles and performance of duties outlined in the RNI County Classification
- Communicates collaboratively with patients, families, the interdisciplinary team and other nursing staff to ensure the highest quality care, patient safety and customer satisfaction.
- Maintains and records daily data collected as required for program reporting, research projects, and as required by the Disease Management Program
- Demonstrates leadership skills, effective communication, teaching skills and ability to work effectively with nursing colleagues to advance the knowledge base, professionalism and quality of nursing practice
- Follows established policies and procedures within their RN scope of practice.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be currently on the DHS Registered Nurse I item
- Current license to practice as a Registered Nurse issued by the California Board of Nursing
- Recent experience working with Pediatric patients and/or patients with Allergy and Immunology Disorders
- Prefer two years recent experience working at the level of an RNI.
- Excellent written and verbal communication, as well as interpersonal and organizational skills
- Excellent critical thinking, decision making, and problem solving skills
- Ability to work in a small work area
- Team player, flexibility, and willingness to adapt to various clinic and patient populations
