High Desert Health System Supervisor (SCNI) – Urgent Care

Seeking a highly qualified Supervising Clinic Nurse I (SCNI) to assume responsibilities for the day-to-day operations in the High Desert Regional Health Center Urgent Care Clinic. The SCNI will provide direct supervisory support to the staff. The SCNI is responsible for oversight of the urgent care nursing team, which rapidly identifies patients by acuity and seeks the appropriate level of care. The SCNI functions as a resource during emergencies, providing direction to the staff and communicating with the providers. The SCNI reports to the Nurse Manager.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supervise nursing staff in the Urgent Care Clinic through coordination of the patient care flow and serving as a clinical resource.
- Create monthly staffing schedules and utilize resources appropriately.
- Verify accuracy of time and attendance for subordinate staff.
- ❖ Conduct monthly staff meetings and effectively communicate with all staff members.
- Plan, implement, and evaluate a competency based education program for each nursing staff for orientation and continuing performance validation.
- Serve as a preceptor and mentor new staff.
- Advocate and promote high quality patient care. Assess the quality of patient care based on direct observations, medical record reviews, and patient satisfaction.
- ❖ Evaluate staffing based on patient care needs and employee competencies.
- Supervise and maintain procurement of equipment and supplies.
- ❖ Interpret, communicate and enforce policies and procedures.
- Formally evaluate employee performance and implement change through valid and reliable performance improvement plans.
- **Execute** evidenced-based practice into a dynamic fast-paced setting.

DESIRABLE OUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of two years recent direct patient care in an Urgent Care Clinic or Emergency Room.
- Experience dealing with any situation that ranges from a simple pathology to a full resuscitative event.
- ❖ ACLS and PALS certified.
