# COUNTYWIDE DATA REPORT FOR PEI PROGRAMS as of March 31, 2016

#### INTRODUCTION

The following report reflects the cumulative data of the PEI Practices being implemented in Los Angeles County by both DMH Directly Operated (DO) clinics and Legal Entity (LE) Providers from 2010-11 to the current fiscal year. The first seven pages contain aggregate data of all the practices implemented by all providers, followed by practice-specific data. The information includes claim utilization by fiscal year, the demographic information of clients served by PEI Practices (gender, age group, ethnicity, and language), and comparative practice statistics (total clients served, total claims, average cost per client, etc.). This report is updated on a quarterly basis. The source of the data is the DMH Integrated System (IS), Integrated Behavioral Health Information System (IBHIS), and PEI Outcome Measures Application (PEI OMA).

### **COUNTYWIDE - PEI ALLOCATIONS AND CLAIMS (PAGE 1)**

### COUNTYWIDE PEI CLAIMS BY FISCAL YEAR

• In Fiscal Year (FY) 2010-11 Countywide (CW) LEs utilized 72% of their PEI allocation with \$143,869,273 in claims while the DOs claimed \$25,688,740. In FY 2011-12, LEs claimed \$183,333,215 which was 79% utilization rate and DOs claimed \$33,742,871. In FY 2012-13, LEs claimed \$208,403,630 which was 79% utilization rate and DOs claimed \$44,820,296. In FY 2013-14, LEs claimed \$213,083,320 with an 81% utilization rate and DOs claimed \$27,577,538. In FY 2014-15, LEs claimed \$199,213,294 with 81% utilization rate while the DOs claimed \$23,741,477.69. As for the current FY 2015-16, LEs claimed \$132,887,088 while the DOs claimed \$3,417.

#### PEI SUBMITTED CLAIMS - FY 2014-15

- Total claims for FY 2014-15 including both LEs and DO clinics were \$203,464,690 as of March 31, 2016; the majority of the claims were claimed to PEI Child at \$146,728,078 and the remaining claims are as follows with PEI TAY at \$39,424,213, PEI Adults at \$9,425,618, PEI Older Adults at \$4,090,547, PEI Special Programs at \$2,548,118, and PEI Training Funds at \$1,248,118.
- Of the total claims for the FY 2014-15, the majority of services were claimed to EPSDT/Medi-Cal for a total of \$159,764,428. The remaining services were claimed to State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) at \$17,565,700, Indigent/Non Medi-Cal at \$9,397,561, and Invoices/Manual Billing reimbursed at \$3,796,235.

### **COUNTYWIDE PEI % TOTAL CLAIMS BY IS PLAN - FY 2014-15**

• 72% of PEI services were claimed to PEI Child, 20% to PEI TAY, 5% to PEI Adult, 2% to PEI Older Adult, and 1% to PEI Special Programs, and 1% to PEI Training Funds.

### COUNTYWIDE - PEI CLIENT DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION - FY 2014-15 (PAGE 2-3)

# UNIQUE CLIENT COUNT BY IS PLAN AND GENDER

• The majority of PEI services were provided to the Child age group with 19,412 male, 15,780 female and 11 unknown/not reported. The second largest age group was TAY with 5,271 male, 5,334 female and 5 unknown/not reported.

#### **GENDER**

System-wide, we served 51% male and 49% female.



#### **AVERAGE COST PER CLIENT**

- To date, 56,074 clients were served in Los Angeles County through PEI funding for the FY 2014-15, with the average cost per client at \$3,582.
- TAY clients had the highest average cost per client at \$4,325, followed immediately by Child clients at \$4,168.

#### UNIQUE CLIENT COUNT BY PEI PLAN AND ETHNICITY

 As of March 31, 2016, Hispanic/Latino had the highest client count in each age group. Overall, 65% of the PEI clients were Hispanic/Latino, 16% African/African American, 10% White, 2% Asian/Pacific Islander, 5% Other/Unknown/Unreported, and <1% American Native. The Asian/Pacific Islander ethnic group is comprised of 16 different ethnic populations, each of which made up less than one percent of the total population served with PEI Programs.

#### **LANGUAGE**

• English was the primary language spoken among those served through PEI programs and services for a total of 40,486, followed by Spanish at 13,498.

# COUNTYWIDE - PEI PRACTICE STATISTICS AND CLAIMS FOR FY 2014-15 (PAGE 4-5)

- For FY 2014-15, the three largest PEI Practices having the highest total number of clients served are MAP with 17,350 clients, TF-CBT with 8,227 clients and Seeking Safety with 7,608.
- For FY 2014-15, there is a concern in the comparison between Core and Non-Core services for MP wherein the 69% Non-Core percentage and PATHS wherein the 75% Non-Core percentage, which is higher than the allowable maximum of 49%.
- For FY 2014-15, the top three PEI Practices with the highest total claim amount are MAP, TF-CBT and Seeking Safety. To-date, claims are at 33% for MAP, TF-CBT at 15% and Seeking Safety at 14%.
- For FY 2014-15, the PEI Practices with the highest Average Cost per Client include MDFT at \$6,408, followed by DTQI at \$5,968, and MST at \$5,706.
- For FY 2014-15, the PEI Practices with the lowest Average Cost per Client include Group CBT at \$849, followed by CORS at \$1,058, and MP at \$1,123.

# **Top DIAGNOSES AT ADMISSION (PAGE 6-7)**

- Of the top diagnoses at admission, Depressive Disorder NOS is the only common diagnosis in all age groups until FY 14-15.
- Countywide as of March 31, 2016, Depressive Disorder NOS is the top diagnosis at admission from FY 2010-11 to FY 2013-14. In FY 2014-15 and FY 2015-16, Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS is the top diagnosis. The hierarchy of the top diagnosis at admission is composed of Hispanic/Latino every fiscal year.

# **ART (PAGE 8-9)**

ART had a total of \$880,416 claims with 76% Core services and 24% Non-Core services. ART providers
have served 403 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,185, with the most common diagnosis at
admission being Oppositional Defiant Disorder. ART client demographic information shows that 69% of



clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 74% of clients are male, 69% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **AF-CBT (PAGE 10-11)**

• AF-CBT had a total of \$1,013,984 claims with 75% Core services and 25% Non-Core services. AF-CBT providers have served 256 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,961, with the most common diagnosis at admission being AD/HD, Combined Type or Hyperactive Impulse Type. AF-CBT client demographic information shows that 86% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 56% of clients are male, 82% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **BSFT (PAGE 12-13)**

BSFT had a total of \$149,565 claims with 97% Core services and 3% Non-Core services. BSFT providers have served 45 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,817, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS. BSFT client demographic information shows that 79% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 56% of clients are female, 71% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **CAPPS (PAGE 14-15)**

• CAPPS had a total of \$396,997 claims with 69% Core services and 31% Non-Core services. CAPPS providers have served 132 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,008, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Mood Disorder NOS. CAPPS client demographic information shows that 95% of clients served are TAY, 55% of clients are male, 67% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **CFOF (PAGE 16-17)**

• CFOF had a total of \$112,657 claims with 93% Core services and 7% Non-Core services. CFOF providers have served 42 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,682, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior NOS. CFOF client demographic information shows that 76% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 52% of clients are female, 55% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **CPP (PAGE 18-19)**

• CPP had a total of \$1,830,270 claims with 92% Core services and 8% Non-Core services. CPP providers have served 1,602 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,308, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disorder of Infancy, Childhood, or Adolescence NOS. CPP client demographic information shows that 88% of clients served are Children between the ages of 0 and 5, 54% of clients are male, 62% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **CBITS (PAGE 20-21)**

• CBITS had a total of \$6,489 claims with 71% Core services and 29% Non-Core services. CBITS providers have served 8 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$811 with the most common diagnosis at admission being Generalized Anxiety Disorder. CBITS client demographic information shows that 50% of clients served are Children between the ages of 0 and 5, 75% of clients are female, 50% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **CORS (PAGE 22-23)**

CORS had a total of \$1,057,141 claims with 93% Core services and 7% Non-Core services. CORS providers have served 977 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,082, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. CORS client demographic information shows



that 67% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 53% of clients are male, 59% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **DTQI (PAGE 24-25)**

• DTQI had a total of \$781,800 claims with 57% Core services and 43% Non-Core services. DTQI providers have served 176 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$4,442 with the most common diagnosis at admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. DTQI client demographic information shows that 68% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 64% of clients are female, 86% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **DBT (PAGE 26-27)**

DBT had a total of \$51,811 claims with 96% Core services and 4% Non-Core services. DBT providers have served 35 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,894, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent, Severe with Psychotic Features. DBT client demographic information shows that 68% of clients served are Adults, 74% of clients are female, 40% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **FOCUS (PAGE 28-29)**

• FOCUS had a total of \$219,323 claims with 88% Core services and 12% Non-Core services. FOCUS providers have served 110 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,994, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Depressive Behavior Disorder NOS. FOCUS client demographic information shows that 81% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 58% of clients are male, 72% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **FFT (PAGE 30-31)**

• FFT had a total of \$1,131,517 claims with 66% Core services and 34% Non-Core services. FFT providers have served 313 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,615, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Oppositional Defiant Disorder. FFT client demographic information shows that 58% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 64% of clients are male, 70% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **GROUP CBT (PAGE 32-33)**

Group CBT had a total of \$44,112 claims with 71% Core services and 29% Non-Core services. Group CBT providers have served 69 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$639, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. Group CBT client demographic information shows that 68% of clients served are Adults, 65% of clients are female, 55% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **IY (PAGE 34-35)**

• IY had a total of \$2,289,419 claims with 59% Core services and 41% Non-Core services. IY providers have served 585 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,914, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS. IY client demographic information shows that 72% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 66% of clients are male, 76% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **IND CBT (PAGE 36-37)**

Ind CBT had a total of \$5,341,583 claims with 85% Core services and 15% Non-Core services. Ind CBT providers have served 2,655 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,012, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. Ind CBT client demographic information shows



that 54% of clients served are Adults, 66% of clients are female, 58% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **IPT (PAGE 38-39)**

• IPT had a total of \$3,098,346 claims with 79% Core services and 21% Non-Core services. IPT providers have served 1,203 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,576, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. IPT client demographic information shows that 29% of clients served are TAY, 70% of clients are female, 63% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **LIFE (PAGE 40-41)**

LIFE had a total of \$230,106 claims with 90% Core services and 10% Non-Core services. LIFE providers
have served 63 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,652, with the most common diagnosis at
admission being Dysthymic Disorder. LIFE client demographic information shows that 90% of clients
served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 52% of clients are male, 81% are Hispanic/Latino and
majority identified English as a primary language.

### **MAP (PAGE 42-43)**

MAP had a total of \$47,315,939 claims with 95% Core services and 5% Non-Core services. MAP providers have served 13,468 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,513 with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS. MAP client demographic information shows that 77% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 56% of clients are male, 74% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **MDFT (PAGE 44-45)**

MDFT had a total of \$88,289 claims with 87% Core services and 13% Non-Core services. MDFT providers have served 11 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$8,026, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS. MDFT client demographic information shows 55% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 82% of clients are male, 82% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# MHIP (PAGE 46-47)

MHIP had a total of \$633,452 claims with 97% Core services and 3% Non-Core services. MHIP providers
have served 541 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,171, with the most common diagnosis at
admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. MHIP client demographic information shows that 68% of
clients served are adults, 67% of clients are female, 52% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified
English as primary language.

# **MP (PAGE 48-49)**

• MP had a total of \$6,758 claims with 8% Core services and 92% Non-Core services. MP providers have served 5 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,352. MP client demographic information shows that 80% of clients served are Children between the ages of 0 and 5, 60% of clients are female, 60% are African/African American and majority identified English as primary language.

### MST (PAGE 50-51)

MST had a total of \$78,269 claims with 83% Core services and 17% Non-Core services. MST providers
have served 18 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$4,348, with the most common diagnosis at
admission being Oppositional Defiant Disorder. MST client demographic information shows that 63% of



clients served are TAY, 89% of clients are male, 78% are Hispanic/Latino, and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **PATHS (PAGE 52-53)**

• PATHS had a total of \$164,018 claims with 33% Core services and 67% Non-Core services. PATHS providers have served 58 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,828, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity, Combined Type or Hyperactive Impulse Type. PATHS client demographic information shows that 98% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 71% of clients are male, 74% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **PCIT (PAGE 54-55)**

• PCIT had a total of \$2,893,649 claims with 85% Core services and 15% Non-Core services. PCIT providers have served 1,057 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,738, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS. PCIT client demographic information shows that 78% of clients served are Children between the ages of 0 and 5, 66% of clients are male, 70% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# **PEARLS (PAGE 56-57)**

• PEARLS had a total of \$43,936 claims with 99% Core services and 1% Non-Core services. PEARLS providers have served 32 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,373 with the most common diagnosis at admission being Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent, Moderate. PEARLS client demographic information shows that 80% of clients served are Older Adults, 59% of clients are female, 34% are Asian/Pacific Islander, and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **PE PTSD (PAGE 58-59)**

• PE PTSD had a total of \$29,834 claims with 96% Core Services and 4% Non-Core services. PE PTSD providers have served 11 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,712 with the most common diagnosis at admission being Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity, Combined Type or Hyperactive Impulse Type. PE PTSD client demographic information shows that 73% of clients served are TAY, 64% of clients are female, 46% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **PST (PAGE 60-61)**

• PST had a total of \$157,473 claims with 90% Core services and 10% Non-Core services. PST providers have served 85 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,853, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent, Moderate. PST client demographic information shows that 70% of clients served are Older Adults, 79% of clients are female, 54% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified Spanish as a primary language.

### **RPP (PAGE 62-63)**

• RPP had a total of \$93,622 claims with 76% Core services and 24% Non-Core services. RPP providers have served 62 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,510, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disorder of Infancy, Childhood, or Adolescence NOS. RPP client demographic information shows that 52% of clients served are Children between the ages of 0 and 5, 52% of clients are male, 66% are Hispanic/Latino majority identified English as a primary language.

### **SS (PAGE 64-65)**

SS had a total of \$12,820,650 claims with 76% Core services and 24% Non-Core services. SS providers
have served 4,076 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,145, with the most common diagnosis at



admission being Depressive Disorder NOS. SS client demographic information shows that 47% of clients served are TAY, 55% of clients are female, 64% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **SF (PAGE 66-67)**

• SF had a total of \$47,420 claims with 57% Core services and 43% Non-Core services. SF providers have served 37 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$1,282, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Mood Disorder NOS. SF client demographic information shows that 62% of clients served are TAY, 76% of clients are male, 84% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **TF-CBT (PAGE 68-69)**

• TF-CBT had a total of \$19,222,382 claims with 85% Core services and 15% Non-Core services. TF-CBT providers have served 5,594 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$3,436, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder. TF-CBT client demographic information shows that 78% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 55% of clients are female, 72% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

# TRIPLE P (PAGE 70-71)

Triple P had a total of \$4,153,811 claims with 60% Core services and 40% Non-Core services. Triple P providers have served 1,586 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,619, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disruptive Behavior Disorder NOS. Triple P client demographic information shows that 68% of clients served are Children between the ages of 6 and 15, 68% of clients are male, 74% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### **UCLA TTM (PAGE 72-73)**


• UCLA TTM had a total of \$167,878 claims with 81% Core services and 19% Non-Core services. UCLA TTM providers have served 69 clients with an Average Cost per Client of \$2,433, with the most common diagnosis at admission being Disorder of Infancy, Childhood, or Adolescence NOS. UCLA TTM client demographic information shows that 60% of clients served are Children between the ages of 0 and 5, 57% of clients are male, 56% are Hispanic/Latino and majority identified English as a primary language.

### No EBP, Unknown EBP, Multiple EBP, Service Strategy (PAGE 74)






