APPROVAL TO AMEND LEGAL ENTITY AGREEMENT WITH TESSIE CLEVELAND COMMUNITY SERVICES CORPORATION (SECOND SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT) (3 VOTES)

#### SUBJECT

Request approval to amend existing Department of Mental Health Legal Entity Agreement with Tessie Cleveland Community Services Corporation to add mental health services for Children, Transition Age Youth, and Older Adults in Service Areas 6, 7, and 8.

#### IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

- 1. Approve and authorize the Director of Mental Health (Director), or his designee, to prepare, sign, and execute an amendment, substantially similar to Attachment A, to the existing Department of Mental Health (DMH) Legal Entity (LE) Agreement with Tessie Cleveland Community Services Corporation (Tessie Cleveland) to provide mental health services for Children, Transition Age Youth and Older Adults in Service Areas (SA) 6, 7, and 8. The amendment will be effective on Board Approval and will add \$1,134,651 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-14, increasing the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) to \$10,134,573.
- 2. Delegate authority to the Director, or his designee, to prepare, sign, and execute future amendments to this LE Agreement, as necessary, and establish as a new MCA, the amount requested in Recommendation 1, and to further amend this LE Agreement as necessary, provided

that: 1) the County's total payments to this contract provider in any fiscal year will not exceed an increase of 20 percent from the last Board approved MCA; 2) any such increase is used to provide additional services, or to reflect program and/or policy changes; 3) your Board has appropriated sufficient funds for all changes; 4) approval of County Counsel, or designee, is obtained prior to any such amendment; 5) County and Contractor may, by written amendments, reduce programs or services and will be consistent with the principles agreed to in the DMH stakeholders' process; and 6) the Director notifies your Board and the Chief Executive Officer of Agreement changes in writing within 30 days after execution of each amendment.

#### PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The recommended actions will allow DMH to amend its LE Agreement with Tessie Cleveland to add Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Full Service Partnership (FSP) and Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS) funded program funds for the provision of mental health services for Children, Transition Age Youth, and Older Adults in South Los Angeles in Supervisorial District 2 in SAs 6, 7, and 8. These services benefit a diverse multi-ethnic population with focused efforts on the underserved and un-served members of the community, including those of low-income.

These mental health services were previously provided by Tessie Cleveland as a subcontracted agency under Special Services for Groups. Subsequently, Tessie Cleveland continued to provide these services under their own legal entity contract with DMH and the previously subcontracted funds were then transferred to Tessie Cleveland through June 30, 2013. For FY 2013-14 legal entity contracts that were to be renewed were extended for a one-year period to facilitate inclusion at a later date of provisions specific to the implementation of the Affordable Care Act. The programs funded by this amendment for Tessie Cleveland were inadvertently not included in that process, and this action will correct that omission by adding the funding to the Contractor's MCA.

The requested increase to Tessie Cleveland's MCA exceeds DMH's delegated authority, thus requiring your Board's approval.

# **Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals**

The recommended action supports the County's Strategic Plan Goal 3, Integrated Delivery Services.

# **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING**

The total costs of this amendment for FY 2013-14 is \$1,134,651, fully funded by Sales Tax Realignment revenue in the amount of \$268,642, Federal Financial Participation (FFP) Medi-Cal revenue in the amount of \$397,566 and State MHSA revenue in the amount of \$468,443. Funding for this amendment is included in DMH's FY 2013-14 Final Adopted Budget.

Funding for future fiscal years will be requested through DMH's annual budget request process.

There are no net County costs associated with the recommended actions

#### FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Tessie Cleveland has service delivery operations in South Los Angeles in Supervisorial District 2

(SAs 6, 7, and 8). Tessie Cleveland is a multipurpose human services organization specializing in delivering creative solutions and working with community partners to meet community needs. Innovative social services are provided to a diverse population that includes underserved and unserved members of the community. A broad range of mental health services is used to provide a comprehensive, integrated system of care for all those referred to the agency. Emphasis is placed on services that are accessible, appropriate, culturally responsive, evidenced-based, and outcome oriented.

The attached Amendment format has been approved as to form by County Counsel. DMH clinical and administrative staff will administer and monitor the Agreement, evaluate programs to ensure that quality services are being provided to clients, and ensure that agreement provisions and Departmental policies are followed.

In accordance with your Board Policy Manual, Section 5.120, Authority to Approve Increases to Board Approved Contract Amount requirements, DMH notified your Board on September 18, 2013 (Attachment B), identifying and justifying the need for requesting a percentage increase exceeding 20 percent.

# **IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

The recommended actions will allow Tessie Cleveland to provide additional MHSA FSP and FCCS mental health services to Children, Transition Age Youth, and Older Adults in SAs 6, 7, and 8.

# AMENDMENT NO. 11

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_, 2013, by and between the COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES (hereafter "County") and <u>Tessie Cleveland Community Services Corporation (hereafter "Contractor").</u>

WHEREAS, County and Contractor have entered into a written Agreement, dated <u>June 4, 2013</u>, identified as County Agreement No. <u>MH120928</u>, and any subsequent amendments (hereafter collectively "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-14 only, County and Contractor intend to amend this Agreement to add Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Full Service Partnership (FSP) Non Medi-Cal/Non Healthy Families in the amount of \$305,400, add MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/Healthy Families in the amount of \$685,000; add MHSA Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS) Non Medi-Cal/Non Healthy Families in the amount of \$34,118; and to add MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/Healthy Families in the amount of \$110,133; and

WHEREAS, for FY 2013-14 only, the total increase will be \$1,134,651, and the revised Maximum Contract Amount will be \$10,134,573, and

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Contractor agree that Agreement shall be amended only as follows:

 For FY 2013-14 only, MHSA FSP Non Medi-Cal/Non Healthy Families are added in the amount of \$305,400, add MHSA FSP Medi-Cal/Healthy Families in the amount of \$685,000; add MHSA Field Capable Clinical Services (FCCS) Non

- Medi-Cal/Non Healthy Families in the amount of \$34,118; and to add MHSA FCCS Medi-Cal/Healthy Families in the amount of \$110,133;
- Financial Exhibit A (FINANCIAL PROVISIONS), Attachment II, Paragraph C (Reimbursement for Initial Period) shall be deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefor:

# "C. REIMBURSEMENT FOR INITIAL PERIOD

- (1) The Maximum Contract Amount for the Initial Period of this Agreement as described in Paragraph 1 (TERM) of the Legal Entity Agreement shall not exceed <u>TEN MILLION ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND</u>

  FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$10,134,573) and shall consist of Funded Programs as shown on the Financial Summary."
- Financial Summary 10 for FY 2013-14, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with Financial Summary 11 for FY 2013-14 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. All references in Agreement to Financial Summary 10 for FY 2013-14, shall be deemed amended to state "Financial Summary 11 for FY 2013-14."
- 4. Financial Summary Subprogram Schedule 10 for FY 2013-14, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with Financial Summary Subprogram Schedule 11 for FY 2013-14 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. All references in Agreement to Financial Summary Subprogram Schedule 10 for FY 2013-14. shall be deemed amended to state "Financial Summary Subprogram Schedule 11 for FY 2013-14."

- Contractor shall provide services in accordance with Contractor's FY
   2011-12 Negotiation Package for this Agreement and any addenda thereto
   approved in writing by the Director.
- 6. Except as provided in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

REQUEST TO INCREASE DELEGATED AUTHORITY PERCENTAGE FOR LEGAL ENTITY AGREEMENT WITH TESSIE CLEVELAND COMMUNITY

SERVICES CORPORATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-14

This memo is to comply with Board Policy Manual, Section 5.120, Authority to Approve Increases to Board-Approved Contract Amounts. The Policy mandates that any department requesting a percentage increase exceeding 20 percent of the total contract amount must provide a detailed justification and advance written notice to your Board, with a copy to the Chief Executive Officer, at least two weeks prior to the Board meeting at which the proposed contract is to be presented.

With the addition of Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Full Service Partnership and MHSA Field Capable Clinical Services program funds, the Department of Mental Health (DMH) requests delegated authority to increase the maximum contract amount for Tessie Cleveland Community Services Corporation (Tessie Cleveland) for Fiscal Year 2013-14.

Tessie Cleveland began providing these services through a subcontract with Special Service for Groups (SSG). The long term goal was for SSG to incubate and mentor Tessie Cleveland to eventually become a Legal Entity (LE) provider. Now that Tessie Cleveland has a LE Agreement with DMH, the subcontracted funds will be transferred from SSG to Tessie Cleveland and Tessie Cleveland will continue to provide the services without interruption to children, transition age youth, and older adults in Service Areas 6, 7, and 8.

Should there be a need to exceed the 20 percent delegated authority, DMH will return to your Board with a request for authority to amend the contract accordingly.
