APPROVAL TO TRANSFER GROUP HOME FUNDS FROM SUNBRIDGE HARBOR VIEW REHABILITATION CENTER, INC., TO BAYFRONT YOUTH AND FAMILY SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2012-13 AND 2013-14 (FOURTH SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

Request approval to amend mental health agreements by decreasing Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center, Inc., funding by \$623,937 and increasing Bayfront Youth and Family Services funding by \$623,937 for the provision of mental health services to the residents of Bayfront Level 14 Group Home.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Approve and authorize the Director of Mental Health (Director), or his designee, to prepare, sign, and execute amendments, substantially similar to the amendment formats in Attachment A, to the existing Department of Mental Health (DMH) Legal Entity (LE) Agreements with Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center, Inc. (Sunbridge), and Bayfront Youth and Family Services (Bayfront), transferring mental health funding from Sunbridge to Bayfront. For Fiscal Year (FY) 2012-13 and FY 2013-14, the annual amount of funds transferred from Sunbridge to Bayfront is \$623,937 per fiscal year, which will be funded by Sales Tax Realignment in the amount of \$311,968 and Federal Financial Participation (FFP) Medi-Cal revenue in the amount of \$311,969. The amendments will be effective upon your Board's approval and will decrease the Sunbridge Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) from \$5,634,328 to \$5,010,391, and increase the Bayfront MCA from \$916,368 to \$1,540,305, in FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14.

2. Delegate authority to the Director, or his designee, to prepare, sign, and execute future amendments to these LE Agreements, as necessary, and establish as a new MCA the aggregate of the original Agreement and all amendments, provided that: 1) the amendments do not exceed an increase of 20 percent from the last Board approved MCA; 2) any such increase is used to provide additional services or to reflect program and/or policy changes; 3) your Board has appropriated sufficient funds for all changes; 4) approval of County Counsel, or designee, is obtained prior to any such amendment; 5) County and Contractor may, by written amendments, reduce programs or services and revise the applicable MCA, provided that any amendments which reduce programs or services are consistent with the principles agreed to in the DMH stakeholders' process; and 6) the Director notifies your Board and the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Agreement changes in writing within 30 days after execution of each amendment.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of the recommended actions will enable Bayfront to continue to provide mental health services to children from Los Angeles County's Department of Children and Family Services and Department of Probation who have not responded to other treatment resources and who are residents of Bayfront Level 14 Group Home.

The annual amount of \$623,937 was originally allocated to Sunbridge to provide mental health services to the residents of a Level 14 Group Home. Bayfront, operating as a separate program under Sunbridge, provided these services prior to becoming a LE contractor in its own right. On December 20, 2011, your Board approved establishment of a LE agreement with Bayfront to provide WrapAround Approach Services. Bayfront Group Home moved from its location at Sunbridge to a new location at Bayfront. Now that Bayfront has been established as a LE contractor and the group home has moved, Sunbridge will no longer provide mental health services to residents. Therefore, a fund transfer from Sunbridge to Bayfront is necessary.

The requested increase to Bayfront's MCA exceeds DMH's delegated authority, thus requiring your Board's approval.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The recommended action supports the County's Strategic Plan Goal 3, Integrated Delivery Services.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The total cost of this amendment for FY 2012-13 is \$623,937 funded by Sales Tax Realignment in the amount of \$311,968 and FFP Medi-Cal revenue in the amount of \$311,969. Funding for this agreement is included in DMH's FY 2012-13 Adopted Budget. Funding for future fiscal years will be requested through DMH's annual budget request process.

There is no net County cost impact associated with this action.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Bayfront Group Home, operating as a separate program under Sunbridge, provided Level 14 group home services since year 2000. Bayfront was established as a LE contractor on December 20, 2011. Bayfront Level 14 Group Home was moved from its Sunbridge location to a new location at Bayfront.

Level 14 group homes are licensed by the State of California as the highest level of group homes in accordance with State requirements for child care and supervision, mental health services and social work activities. Children from Los Angeles County's Department of Children and Family Services and Department of Probation are placed in these group homes. DMH provides funding for mental health services, specifically Day Treatment Intensive and Medication Support, while they are in residence. Bayfront Group Home is a unique 29-bed Level 14 residential treatment facility that features an intensely structured mental health treatment program for adolescents ages 11 ½ to 17 years who have not responded to other treatment resources and community care facilities in Los Angeles County.

The attached Amendment formats have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

In accordance with your Board Policy Manual, Section 5.120, Authority to Approve Increases to Board Approved Contract Amounts requirements, DMH notified your Board on July 24, 2012 (Attachment B), identifying and justifying the need for requesting a percentage increase exceeding 10 percent.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

The recommended actions will allow Bayfront to serve severely emotionally disturbed children and adolescents who need a highly structured setting to benefit from mental health services.

WHEREAS, for FYs 2012-13 and 2013-14, County and Contractor intend to amend Agreement to <u>increase</u> Medi-Cal/Healthy Families funding for FY 2012-13 and FY 2013-14 in the amount of \$623,937 and \$623,937, respectively for the provision of

Day Treatment Intensive and Medication Support services for Bayfront Level 14 Group Home residents; and

WHEREAS, for FYs 2012-13 and 2013-14, the Maximum Contract Amounts (MCA) are <u>increased</u> by \$623,937 and \$623,937, and the revised MCAs are \$1,540,305 and \$1,540,305, respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Contractor agree that Agreement shall be amended, effective upon Board approval, only as follows:

REQUEST TO INCREASE DELEGATED AUTHORITY PERCENTAGE

FOR THE LEGAL ENTITY AGREEMENT WITH BAYFRONT YOUTH AND FAMILY SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2012-13 AND 2013-14

This memorandum is to comply with Board Policy Manual, Section 5.120, Authority to Approve Increase to Board Approved Contract Amount. The Policy mandates that any department requesting a percentage increase exceeding 20 percent of the total contract amount must provide a detailed justification and advance written notice to your Board, with a copy to the Chief Executive Officer, at least two weeks prior to the Board meeting at which the proposed contract is to be presented.

With the addition of Level 14 group home program funds, the Department of Mental Health (DMH) requests delegated authority to increase the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) of Bayfront Youth and Family Services (Bayfront) which will exceed the 20 percent delegated authority for Fiscal Years 2012-13 and 2013-14.

Bayfront Level 14 Group Home is a unique 29-bed Level 14 residential treatment facility that features an intensely structured mental health treatment program for adolescents ages 11½ to 17 who have not responded to other treatment resources and community care facilities in Los Angeles County. This authority will allow Bayfront to serve severely emotionally disturbed children and adolescents who need a highly structured setting to benefit from mental health services. DMH recently established a LE agreement with Bayfront with the MCA of \$916,368, to provide Wraparound Approach Services. An annual amount of \$623,937 was originally allocated to Sunbridge Harbor View Rehabilitation Center, Inc. (Sunbridge), to provide mental health services to Bayfront Level 14 Group Home. Now that Bayfront has established itself as a LE contractor and the group home has moved to Bayfront's new location, Sunbridge will no longer provide mental health services to residents. Therefore, a transfer of funds from Sunbridge to Bayfront is necessary. The delegated authority will allow Bayfront to provide mental health services to children at a Level 14 group home, the highest level of group home in accordance with State requirements.
