### Dear Supervisors:

#### APPROVAL TO AMEND 31 LEGAL ENTITY AGREEMENTS TO ADD CALIFORNIA WORK OPPORTUNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY TO KIDS FUNDING FOR MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE REMAINING SIX MONTHS OF FISCAL YEAR 2010-11 (ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS) (3 VOTES)

### **SUBJECT**

Request approval to amend 31 Legal Entity Agreements to add funding to California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids programs to continue mental health services without interruption on a month-to-month basis for the remaining six months of Fiscal Year 2010-11.

## IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

1. Approve and authorize the Director of Mental Health, or his designee, to prepare, sign, and execute amendments, substantially similar in format to Attachment A, to add California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) funding to 31 existing Legal Entity (LE) Agreements that provide CalWORKs services, as listed in Attachment B, in order to continue providing mental health services on a month-to-month basis, for the next six months, beginning January 1, 2011 through June 30, 2011.

2. Delegate authority to the Director of Mental Health, or his designee, to prepare, sign, and execute future amendments to these LE Agreements provided that: 1) approval by County Counsel, or designee, is obtained prior to any such Amendment; 2) County and contractor may, by written Amendment, reduce programs or services and revise the applicable Maximum Contract Amount (MCA); 3) any revisions are used to provide additional services or to reflect program or Board policy changes; and 4) the Director of Mental health notifies your Board and the Chief Executive Officer

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(CEO) of Agreement changes in writing within 30 days after execution of each Amendment.

### PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Board approval is required to execute Amendments to 31 LE Agreements that provide CalWORKs services on a month-to-month basis, for a six-month period, in order to continue with their CalWORKs funding and to avoid interruption in services. On June 9, 2010, your Board approved an initial six-month extension for these 31 LE Agreements to allow the Department of Mental Health (DMH) time to complete its Request for Proposals (RFP) process. However, following notification of the evaluation outcomes, 21 proposers requested and completed debriefings. Of those, four proposers in five different service areas requested advancement to the next phase in the protest process, the Proposed Contractor Selection Review. This stage is pending the finalization of negotiations with selected proposers. The six-month extension will allow DMH the time required to resolve the appeals and award contracts to the selected proposers.

### **Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals**

The recommended actions support the County's Strategic Plan Goal 4, Health and Mental Health.

### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING**

There is no net County cost.

The month-to-month funding to add the additional CalWORKs allocation for 31 LE Agreements is through an Intrafund Transfer from the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) in the amount of \$6,705,700. Funding is included in DMH's 2010-11 Final Budget.

The monthly disbursement of funds to the 31 LE Agreements will be based upon submitted claims for mental health services provided to CalWORKs recipients. The monthly disbursements will be limited to one-sixth of the six-month allocation.

## FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The request for the month-to-month addition of CalWORKs allocation will allow DMH to address the appeals and complete its contract negotiation process for the RFP. Current contract providers of CalWORKs services will be able to continue providing the necessary services without interruption to allow the solicitation process to be finalized with the successful RFP awardees and will meet the State requirement for CalWORKs allocation.

The extended CalWORKs funding will not be included when computing the 20 percent increase allowed over the last applicable Board-approved MCA.

The Amendment format has been approved as to form by County Counsel. The CEO has reviewed the proposed actions.

DMH will continue to supervise and monitor Contractors' adherences to the Agreements' provisions

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and DMH policies and that performance outcomes are being achieved.

### **CONTRACTING PROCESS**

On January 11, 2010, DMH issued a RFP to provide CalWORKs mental health supportive services. The issuance of the RFP is in accordance with State requirements regarding the allocation of CalWORKs funding within Los Angeles County. The RFP was distributed to agencies on the Departmental Bidders list which included minority agencies. Announcements were published in local community and ethnic newspapers as well as DMH's own Internet site.

On February 2, 2010, DMH held a mandatory bidders' conference that was attended by 170 people, representing 106 agencies. DMH received 54 complete proposals by February 23, 2010. Seven panels, comprised of individuals representing the Department of Public Health, DPSS and DMH, met in mid-March to review and evaluate the proposals' program components on a standard evaluation scale. Based on the evaluation panel scores and a commitment to distribute the funds regionally across the County, DMH reviewed and finalized the recommendations for funding 31 LEs as detailed in Attachment B. After notification of the RFP results, 21 debriefings were requested by 15 agencies, some of whom submitted proposals for multiple service areas. After completing the 21 requested debriefings, four agencies requested Proposer Contractor Selection Reviews in five different service areas. This stage of the review process is pending until negotiations with the recommended award recipients are finalized.

The final award recipients are to be determined during the extension period of January 1, 2011 through June 30, 2011. Should any of the existing 31 LE Contractors not be awarded CalWORKs funds as the result of the RFP process, those Contractors will be given 30 days to transition their existing CalWORKs participants to those successful CalWORKs awardees under contract with DMH. RFP process and protest requirements prevented DMH from completing the RFP solicitation process before the beginning of the new contract term on December 31, 2010.

The Department will return to your Board to request authority to award CalWORKs funding contracts to the successful proposers.

## **IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

The 31 LE Contractors have existing agreements with DMH, and the addition of CalWORKs funding to these contract service providers is being requested to continue providing services without interruption, pending DMH's completion of the RFP process.

WHEREAS, County and Contractor intend to amend Agreement to <u>add</u> California Work Opportunity and Responsibility To Kids (CalWORKs) funding in this Agreement on a month-to-month basis for the remaining six months of Fiscal Year (FY) 2010-11, beginning January 1, 2011 through June 30, 2011 to allow contract negotiations to be finalized for the CalWORKs solicitation process; and

WHEREAS, for FY 2010-11 only, the total monthly CalWORKs expenditures shall not exceed one sixth (1/6<sup>th</sup>) of FY 2010-11 allowable CalWORKs Maximum Program Amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_; and

WHEREAS, for FY 2010-11 only, the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) shall be increased by \$\_\_\_\_\_, with a revised MCA of \$\_\_\_\_\_.

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NOW, THEREFORE, County and Contractor agree that Agreement shall be amended only as follows:

- Financial Exhibit A (FINANCIAL PROVISIONS), Attachment II, Paragraph C (Reimbursement for Initial Period) shall be deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefore:
  - "C. REIMBURSEMENT FOR INITIAL PERIOD

(1) The Maximum Contract Amount for the Initial Period of this Agreement as described in Paragraph 1 (TERM) of the Legal Entity Agreement shall not exceed\_\_\_\_\_

\_\_\_\_\_DOLLARS (\$\_\_\_\_\_) and shall consist of Funded Programs as shown on the Financial Summary."

All references in Agreement to Financial Summary \_ for FY 2010-11 shall be deemed amended to state "Financial Summary \_ for FY 2010-11."
- 3. Financial Summary \_ for FY 2011-12, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with Financial Summary \_ for FY 2011-12 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. All references in Agreement to Financial Summary \_ for FY 2011-12 shall be deemed amended to state "Financial Summary \_ for FY 2011-12." (if applicable)
- 4. Financial Summary \_ for FY 2012-13, shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with Financial Summary \_ for FY 2012-13 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. All references in Agreement to Financial Summary \_ for FY 2012-13

shall be deemed amended to state "Financial Summary - \_ for FY 2012-13." (if applicable)

- 6. Except as provided in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
