MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS FOR

DECEMBER 2016

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of five Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal (MC) Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs, and execution of two new Agreements processed in the month of December 2016 as follows:

- 1. **Agreement (MH190138) with Pacific Clinics** is a newly executed Drop-In Center for Transition-Age Youth (TAY) Services Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on December 1, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2017.
- 2. **Agreement (MH220052) with TurningWest, Inc.,** is a newly executed Project Management Services Strategic Management Agreement. The term of this Agreement commenced on December 20, 2016, and shall continue through June 30, 2019.

The following one Amendment (3) increases MHSA Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Non-MC Funded Program funds:

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3. Amendment No. 32 (MH121114) with Child and Family Guidance Center for Fiscal Year (FY) 2016-17 increases MHSA PEI Non-MC Funded Program funds in the amount of \$63,000. The revised MCA is \$30,495,039.

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Addendum for July 2016
