SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 126 Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal (MC) Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs, and execution of 3 new Agreements processed in the month of May 2015 as follows:

1. **Memorandum of Space Use Agreement with Tarzana Treatment Centers, Inc.**, for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, and 2017-18, the Board of Supervisors approved this co-located project to provide healthcare services at the Department's directly-operated San Fernando Mental Health Center that establishes a one-stop health and behavioral health center in a community-based behavioral health setting. There is no monetary payment between Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health (DMH) and Tarzana Treatment Center.
2. **Agreement (2014-RW-BX-0007) with Department of Justice** is a Grant award and special conditions Agreement in the amount of \$600,000 for a two-year period from October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2016, for the Second Chance Act Reentry Program for Adult offenders with Co-Occurring Substance Abuse and Mental Health Disorders (Second Chance Act).
3. **Agreement (MH220023) with InterACT Computing Enterprise, Inc.**, is a Master Agreement for Project Management Service Act for FYs 2014-15 through 2017-18. There is no MCA for this contract.
