SUBJECT: **MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS/AMENDMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 47 Amendments to existing and/or new Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), Clinical Assessment programs, and execution of 31 new Agreements processed in the month of April 2013 as follows:

1. **Agreement (MH010100) with Pepperdine University** is being executed under the Affiliation Agreement for Student Professional Development Programs. The term of the Agreement is from January 24, 2013, through June 30, 2017.
2. **Amendment No. 2 (MH050054) with The University of Washington** revises the Statement of Work (SOW) to reflect changes agreed upon by both parties related to such elements as training purpose, format, length, participant qualifications, number of participants, and cost for training, and post-implementation deliverables which resulted in reduction to the Total Compensation Amount (TCA) in the amount of \$105. The revised TCA is \$1,573,865.
3. **Amendment No. 2A (MH120865) with Institute for Multicultural Counseling & Education Services, Inc. (I.M.C.E.S.)**, shifts Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) training funds in the amount of \$4,864 to PEI Transition Age Youth (TAY) Non Medi-Cal/Non Healthy Families (HF).
4. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120899) with Dignity Health dba California Hospital Medical Center** adds Mode 15, Service Function Codes (SFCs) 70-79, and Crisis Intervention to Provider No. (PN) 7590; Exhibit 8 shall be added to Agreement and Service Delivery Site Exhibit; and current Attachment V shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with revised Attachment V, Service Delivery Site Exhibit 1. There is no change to the Maximum Contract Amount (MCA).

5. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120905) with Dubnoff Center for Child Development and Educational Therapy (Dubnoff)** entered into a merger with Penny Lane Centers that required decreases to the MCA of various Program Funds to meet financial obligations for services provided by Dubnoff through February 28, 2013. Decreases included Specialized Foster Care-Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) Multidisciplinary Assessment Team (MAT) Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$6,000; decreases DCFS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$17,000; decreases Juvenile Justice Program Supportive Treatment Option Program (STOP) funds in the amount of \$39,000; decreases Juvenile Justice Program Co-occurring Disorder funds in the amount of \$5,000; decreases Juvenile Justice Program (JJCPA-MHSAT) funds in the amount of \$35,000; under County General Funds (CGF), decreases Department of Mental Health (DMH) Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$400,000; under Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), decreases PEI Non Medi-Cal/Non HF funds in the amount of \$24,000; decreases PEI Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$200,000; and under Unique MHSA, decreases Probation Camp Program funds in the amount of \$40,000. The revised MCA is \$1,658,815.
6. **Amendment No. 1 (MH120934) with VIP Community Mental Health Center, Inc.**, increases DCFS Medical Hubs (VIP) funds in the amount of \$79,647. The revised MCA is \$7,398,214.
7. **Amendment No. 14 (MH120965) with Telecare Corporation** decreases Alternative Crisis Services (ACS) Non Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$36,500 and increases ACS Medi-Cal/HF funds in the amount of \$73,000. The revised MCA is \$14,017,605.
8. **Agreement (MH150298) with Pacific Healthcare, Inc., dba Better Value Pharmacy** is being executed under the Pharmacy Agreement. The term of the Agreement is from April 4, 2013, through June 30, 2015.
9. **Amendment No. 5 (MH190063) with ValueOptions, Inc.**, intends to exercise the second and last of the two one-year extension options to amend the Agreement for one year, beginning July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014. There is no change to the MCA.
10. **Amendments No. 3 (MH190074) with Phillips Graduate Institute** intends to exercise the second and last of the two one-year extension options to the Agreement. The extension of the term will be from July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014, and will continue offering stipends to Marriage and Family Therapists (MFTs) second year students. Also, replaces the Health Insurance

Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) language. The MCA will remain the same.

11. **Amendment No. 1 (MH190094) with Didi Hirsch Psychiatric Service, dba Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services and California Mental Health Services Authority** shifts funds in Fiscal Years (FYs) 2011-12, 2012-13, and 2013-14 to accommodate modified start date from staff as follows: decreases salaries and benefits for FY 2011-12 by \$33,161 and increases overtime expense by \$16,580,050, for FYs 2012-13 and 2013-14. Computer equipment expense is decreased by \$1,200 for FY 2011-12 and increased by \$1,200 for FY 2012-13 only. Office supplies expense is decreased by \$300 for FY 2011-12 and increased by \$300 and for FY 2012-13 only. Telecommunication System/Network Infrastructure purchases decreases by \$9,902 for FY 2011-12 and increases by \$9,902 for FY 2012-13 only. iCarol Data Software purchase expense decreases for FY 2011-12 by \$1,246 and increases by \$1,246 for FY 2012-13 only. Expenses for mileage, utilities, and iCarol license fees are reallocated to office space for FY 2011-12 only. There is no change to the subcontract amount.
12. **Agreement (MH190110) with The Los Angeles Gay and Lesbian Community Services Center** is being executed under the Enhanced Emergency Shelter Program for TAY Agreement. The term of the Agreement is from March 25, 2013, through June 30, 2017.
13. **Agreement (MH190111) with Otsuka America Pharmaceutical, Inc.**, is being executed under the Pharmaceutical Rebate Agreement. The term of the Agreement is from April 1, 2013, through March 31, 2015.
14. **Agreement (MH190112) with City of Burbank** is being executed under the Revenue Agreement, Memorandum of Cooperative Agreement (MOCA) between the DMH and the City of Burbank. The term of the Agreement is for 12 months, renewable automatically unless terminated by either party. The City will reimburse DMH staff costs up to \$100,000 annually.
15. **Amendment No. 4 (MH210017) with Northeast Community Clinic** deletes PN 4049, located at 3751 S. Harvard Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90018. The MCA will remain the same.
