SUBJECT: **AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS**

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 193 Amendments to existing Legal Entity (LE) Agreements, Specialized Agreements, Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual and Group Providers), and Clinical Assessment programs processed in the month of June, as follows:

- Amendment No. 5 (MH050013) with California Institute for Mental Health (CIMH)** adds Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funding by \$47,000 for the Functional Family Therapy (FFT) training to County of Los Angeles Department of Mental Health clinicians in Service Area 8. The revised Maximum Contract Amount (MCA) will be \$2,033,658.
- Amendment No. 8 (MH050013) with CIMH** adds MHSA funding for different provisions. It adds \$50,000 for Wellness, Recovery, and Resiliency Cultural Adaptation Project, \$50,000 for American Indian Learning Collaborative Project, and \$128,500 for Consultation Services. The revised MCA will be \$2,383,908.
- Amendment No. 1 (MH050017) with Pacific Clinics** extends the term of the agreement for a period of 12 more months, beginning July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. It also adds MHSA funding by \$93,150 with a revised MCA of \$558,900.
- Amendment No. 3 (MH050019) with Mental Health America of Los Angeles (Consultant Services Agreement)** extends the term of the agreement for a period of 12 more months, beginning July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009, to continue MHSA Community Services and Supports (CSS) funding for the Workforce Training Services program to provide Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialist Training Services, the College Faculty Immersion Program and the DMH Staff Immersion Training Program. Adds MHSA funding in the amount of \$1,135,000 with a revised MCA of \$1,135,000.

5. **Amendment No. 13 (MH120144) with Pacific Clinics** moved their Pacific Clinics Older Adult (OA) Full Service Partnership (FSP) service site for Provider Number (PN) 7677 from 269 S. Mariposa Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90004, to 2500 Wilshire Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA 90057 under PN 7678. Services to be provided under PN 7678 are Targeted Case Management Services (TCMS) (Mode 15, Service Function Codes (SFCs) 01-09) at \$1.91; Mental Health Services (MHS) (Mode 15, SFCs 10-19/30-59) at \$2.47; Medication Support (Mode 15, SFCs 60-69) at \$4.56; Crisis Intervention (Mode 15, SFCs 70-79) at \$3.67; Outreach Services (Mode 45, SFCs 10-19/20-29) at \$60.00; and Client Supportive Services (Cost Reimbursement). There is no change to the MCA.
6. **Amendment No. 8 (MH120162) with Hillview Mental Health Center, Inc.,** shifts \$150,000 from non-Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (non-EPSDT) – County General Funds (CGF) to Local Mental Health Plan (MHP) non-Medi-Cal CGF funds. It shifts \$105,000 MHSA Transition Age Youth (TAY) FSP Flex Funds to TAY FSP Federal Financial Participation (FFP). It shifts \$35,000 MHSA Adult FSP Flex Funds to Adult FSP MHS funds. Lastly it shifts \$20,000 MHSA Adult FSP Flex Funds to Adult FSP FFP. The revised MCA will be \$9,757,525.
7. **Amendment No. 9 (MH120173) with Providence Community Services, LLC** shifts Schiff-Cardenas – Mental Health Screening, Assessment, and Treatment (MHSAT) funds in the amount of \$85,000 to Schiff-Cardenas – Multi-Systemic Therapy Program (MST). It also deletes MHSA-FSP and MHSA-Family Supportive Services (FSS) under PN 7572. There is no change to the MCA.
8. **Amendment No. 5 (MH120177) with South Central Health and Rehabilitation Program (SHARP)** sets forth the parties' understanding and agreement with respect to the disposition of certain funds provided to the contractor through the Program formerly known as Assembly Bill 2034 (AB 2034). Contractor will utilize these funds for the development of six (6) one (1) bedroom, one (1) bathroom permanent supportive housing units for individuals formerly enrolled in the AB 2034 program or currently enrolled in the FSP Program over the next ten (10) years. The units are located at 6808 South Hoover Street, Los Angeles, CA 90044.

There is no change to the MCA.
