SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENTS

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director of Mental Health by your Board, this is notification of the execution of 39 amendments to existing Legal Entity Agreements, Specialized Agreements, and Medi-Cal Professional Services Agreements (Individual) processed in the month of September, as follows:

- 1. Amendment No. 4 (DMH-01494) with Asian Rehabilitation Services, Inc., changes the method of payment from Cost Reimbursement to Negotiated Rate for the period of July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004 for vocational services for Fiscal Year (FY) 2003-2004.
- 2. Amendment No. 1 (DMH-01629) with Asian Rehabilitation Services, Inc., changes the method of payment from Cost Reimbursement to Negotiated Rate for the period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2007 for vocational services for FYs 2004-2005, 2005-2006, and 2006-2007.
- 3. Amendment No. 1 (DMH-01634) with Child and Family Guidance Center, decreases in Schiff-Cardenas funds (Probation Multi Systematic Therapy (MST)) in the amount of \$5,000 for FY 2004-2005 and expands the Family Stress Center by providing services adjacent to the building located at 16861 Parthenia Street, North Hills, CA 91343 for Provider Number 7247.
- 4.
