This didactic and experiential training is designed for all levels of staff including but not limited to clinical and administrative staff providing services within the Public Mental Health system to diverse communities, including but not limited to the LGBTQ+, African-American, Asian Pacific Islander, Latina/o and other communities. The three-hour training will incorporate material within the psycho-socio-political context of consumers' lives and the power imbalance which can exist within such interactions. Participants are expected to develop greater awareness and insight important to attain respectful engagement with consumers, particularly those consumers who have experienced marginalization and a lack of access to formal systems, including the public mental health system. Didactic components as well as experiential exercises and discussions enhance the integration of the training topics. Participants will be challenged to identify activities which can be implemented immediately in working towards more just systems.

TARGET AUDIENCE: DMH & Contract Provider Staff

OBJECTIVES: As a result of attending this training, participants will be able to:

1. Develop a personal and dynamic understanding of Cultural Humility.
2. Increase knowledge of the significance of Intersectionality which creates overlapping and interdependent systems of discrimination.
3. Identify areas in their own lives where they have Unearned Privilege as well as areas where they have experienced Oppression.
4. Recognize the stages of Anti-oppression Identity Development.
5. Identify the impact of Stigma on Mental Health Services seeking behavior, and how to addresses these behaviors.
