Discussion will address the components of "Trauma Informed Care," and will present participants with strategies to address the effects of PTSD. Trauma Informed Care is strength based approach and provides a context to better understand and assist justice involved consumers experiencing PTSD. Participants will: learn self-soothing strategies, use of self-care techniques, and identify other interventions to manage symptoms of PTSD.
