Emergency and essential services (Sheriff, Fire, emergency operations, hospitals and clinics) will continue to operate, along with other work deemed critical by County department heads, such as urgent communicable disease investigations and urgent inspectional services. The Disaster Recovery Centers established after the Woolsey Fire will be open from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
