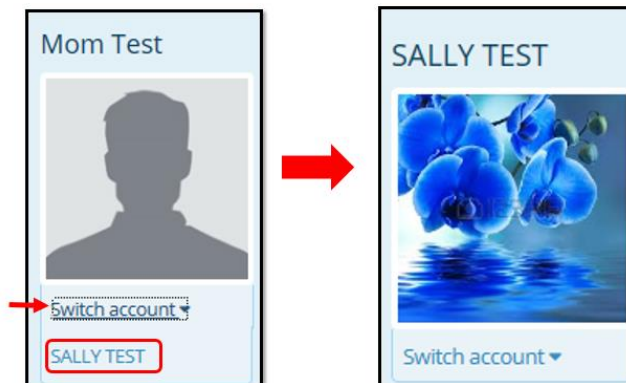

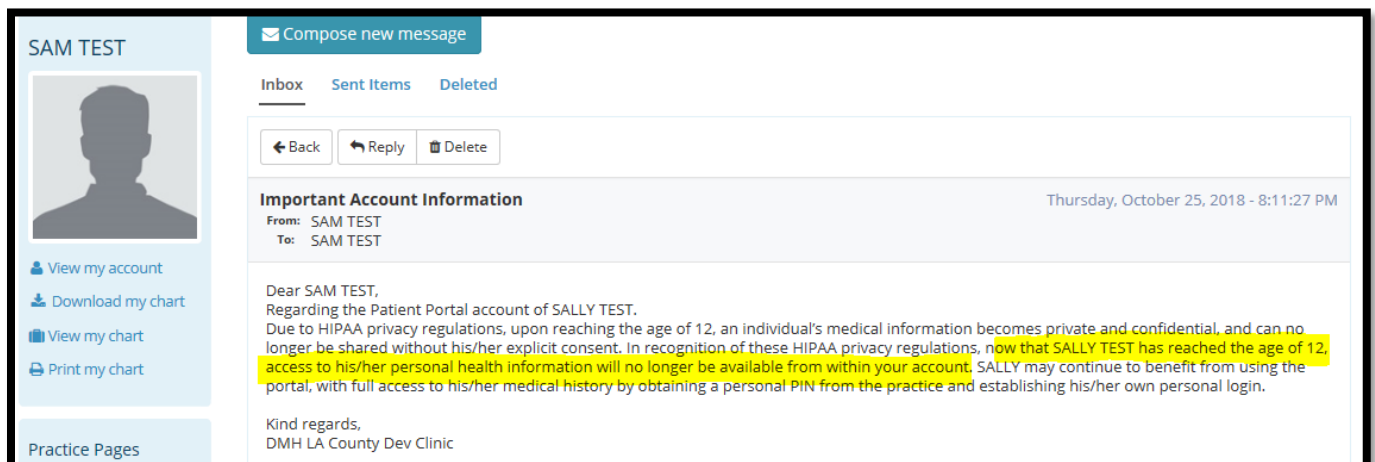

- After you hit Continue, then complete your child’s information including their **PIN**

- After you hit Complete, you will be in the Client Portal. To view your child’s online record, select **Switch account** under your photo and click on his/her account



- When your child or dependent turns 12 years old, access to his/her account will be automatically removed and you will receive the following secure message:



- At that time, your 12-year-old child or dependent can get a new PIN from the Front Desk and set up his/her own personal login. The child can then link the parent to his/her account if he/she chooses.
