## DOCUMENTING AND CLAIMING FOR TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT (TCM) & REHABILITATION SERVICES

The Documenting and Claiming for Targeted Case Management (TCM) and Rehabilitation Services training will provide a basic overview of the essential elements of documentation and claiming based on Short Doyle/Medi-Cal (SD/MC) Standards with an emphasis on TCM and Rehabilitation services. This training will address the importance of establishing Medical Necessity and maintaining the Clinical Loop in documentation for Medi-Cal reimbursement. Also highlighted are the reimbursable service components involved in the provision, documentation and claiming of TCM and Rehabilitation as well as other related requirements based on the DMH Organizational Provider's Manual. The intent of the training is to assist staff providing TCM and Rehabilitation services appropriately document and utilize procedure codes for the provision of those services. Lecture, discussions, handouts, and activities will promote the application of these important documentation elements.

**PRE-REQUISITE:** Completion of Understanding Documentation: Medical Necessity, Documentation and Reimbursable Service Components training

**OBJECTIVES:** **As a result of attending this training, participants should be able to:**

1. Identify the core elements of Medical Necessity and the Clinical Loop.
2. Discuss the reimbursable Service Components involved in the provision of TCM and Rehabilitation services.
3. Demonstrate the ability to evaluate and document consumer needs for TCM and Rehabilitation services.
4. Demonstrate the ability to develop TCM and Rehabilitation related interventions and document them in the Client Treatment Plan.
5. Demonstrate ways to link TCM and Rehabilitation interventions to the identified mental health needs of the consumer in the Progress Note.
6. Identify appropriate procedure codes for TCM and Rehabilitation.
