 - Added a business rule to warn the user when FTE hours across all associated service locations is between forty and fifty-nine hours.
 - Added a business rule to prevent a user to save a record when FTE hours across all associated service locations is greater than sixty hours.
 - Set the minimum acceptable value to one in the Current Number of Medical Beneficiaries field.
 - Removed FTE 0-20 and FTE 21+ Age Group Served fields (does not affect FTE hours fields).

 - Added a rule to prevent duplicate associated practitioners to a single service location.
 - Added rule to accept only ten numeric characters for Fax Number and Intake Telephone.

- Added primary and secondary contact fields.
- Changed the Accessible By field from single option set to multi-select option set.
- Removed Record Complete field from the associated practitioner list.
- Changed the Age Groups Served section name to Population Served.
- Practitioner Form
 - Added rule to hide the Please Specify Other Population/Capabilities field unless Other Population/Cultural value is selected.
 - Added a rule in the Year field to accept only a four-digit year for Cultural Competence Training.
 - Changed the Special Population & Discipline section name to Special Population.
 - Changed the Hours field in Cultural Competence Training to allow for decimal values.
 - Changed Month, Hours, and Year fields from optional to required for Cultural Competence Training.
 - Moved Discipline Type and California Practitioner License Number to the Personal Identification Section.
- Service Location Practitioner Form
 - Added rule to set the FTE hours field as required when Age Group Served is Yes.
 - Changed the minimum value from one to zero for the Distance Practitioner Travels to Field-Based Svc field.
 - Changed field data type to Integer for Current Number of Medi-Cal Beneficiaries and Maximum Number of Medi-Cal Beneficiaries.
 - Changed the minimum value from zero to one for the Maximum Number of Beneficiaries field.
- Changed all checkbox fields to a multi-select option set for Language Capabilities, Age Groups Served, and Special Population.

- Ability to view a list of Practitioners that are associated to a selected DO Service Location.
- Ability to search for a Practitioner by name and NPI.
- Ability to create Practitioner records that is specific to the selected DO Service Location.
- Ability to view and update Practitioner metadata that is specific to the selected DO Service Location.
- Ability to view and update the Practitioner's main record.
- Ability to deactivate records that are no longer associated to an Organization or Service Location.

Portal:
