The Documenting and Claiming for Targeted Case Management (TCM) and Rehabilitation Services training will provide a basic overview of the essential elements of documentation and claiming based on Short Doyle/Medi-Cal (SD/MC) Standards with an emphasis on TCM and Rehabilitation services. The intent of the training is to assist staff providing TCM and Rehabilitation services appropriately document and utilize procedure codes for the provision of those services.
