DISCUSSIONS	RECOMMENDATIONS/DECISIONS
 Community has been "over-researched" with data studies and needs assessments: need to create a tangible product that is accessible to the entire community Current grants and resources tend to be agency-specific; a need for a cross-organization project available to the collective community is desirable. Focus on mental health education and advocacy. 	Create a collaborative website that is cross-cutting across all American Indian service organizations. Website would serve as a portal for all things Indian related in Los Angeles with an emphasis on mental health services and resources. Webmaster would be hired within the community and a launch party would serve as the main PR community event. Cost of ongoing web maintenance would be covered by available UREP funds or shared by agencies.
UREP Membership open to everyone. Specialized ad-hoc committee to be determined by chairs with representation from all American Indian agencies and organizations.	Ben Hale appointed as delegate/ Elton Naswood Alternate: Duties will be shared between both.
