Hollywood Mental Health Center - primarily an outpatient clinic; preparing for the TRIESTE project in 2020

Downtown Mental Health Center – primarily provides PEI and co-located services

Northeast Mental Health Center and Wellness Clinic – primarily provides wellness services through partnerships to promote positive health, personal, and spiritual outcomes

- Jessie Cho gained confidence and self-esteem eliminating social isolation while participating in the creative writing group
- Nathan Cambridge developed steps to move forward from participating in the creative writing group
- George Bernal progressed from social isolation to purpose, patience, faith and perseverance in the role of peer advocate

B. Peer Resource Center – Catherine Clay

Ms. Clay spoke about Peer Resource Center's (PRC) accomplishments and changes during the past two years.

- Networking opportunities:
 - a) SAAC 4 and the faith based program conduct monthly meetings at the facility
 - b) DMH Leadership Team members speak once a month
 - c) WRAP trainings held at PRC
- Increased transparency transparency has improved because of changes in leadership
- Served approximately 3,066 people over the past 2 years
