Spanish Translation Project	Ms. Anna Perne, from the Office of Consumer Family Affairs did a presentation pertaining to some clinical documents that were translated into Spanish and want the subcommittee to review them and ensure that they were accurately translated.
Anna Perne	The Department of Mental Health is mandated by Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) to translate documents into the 13 threshold languages that are spoken in our county. The goal is to deliver services to the entire county, and to make sure our diverse community is able to access, read and understand the information. In order to achieve that goal, documents must be translated and written at a 6 th grade level and should be culturally sensitive. Anna provided the documents that were translated from English to Spanish. She welcomed and encouraged any feedback from the attendees. Submission is within 3 to 4 weeks. In addition, she recruited a couple of volunteers from this group to review the documents.
RAND Session Debriefing	It was a great turnout and there was an exceptional representation from the Latino UsCC.

Legal entities and DMH line staff can join as members B. Election of New Co-Chairs 1. Someone who is a community member or consumer 2. Someone who can advocate for the Latino community, and has the passion to serve the community 3. The Co-Chair needs to attend two meetings a month – The UsCC Leadership meeting and the Latino UsCC meeting 4. He/she needs to facilitate and lead the meeting The current UsCC by-laws allow DMH employee to be a co-chair of a UsCC subcommittee. However, YourDMH prohibits DMH staff or DMH contractors to hold a co-Chair position. By-laws need to be revised to align with the YourDMH initiative. Co-chair should be someone from the community: a community advocate, a consumer or family of the consumers. The co-chair candidate does not need to speak English because DMH provides interpreters at the meetings.
