Review of the Code of Conduct	The Code of Conduct was not read to the subcommittee, everyone was in agreement. It was announced that signing is voluntary.
Updates:	<ul> <li>A. <u>DMH Updates:</u> We had our third UsCCs &amp; SAAC's Stakeholders Meeting. It was held this morning November 19, 2019, from 9:30am – 12:30pm. Hector Ramirez and Paco Retana were there representing the Latino subcommittee. The UsCC subcommittees concentrate on specific cultural groups, like people of color and immigrants. The SAAC subcommittees concentrate on MH services for a specific area. The objective is to join the two subcommittees so they can work together and increase outreach.</li> <li>1. How to create a platform to increase communication between the two subcommittees.</li> </ul>

<ol> <li>How to identify mutual goals to better serve the community, and where the greatest need exists.</li> <li>How the two subcommittees can collaborate with each other so their mission and goals are greater and more impactful for the department.</li> <li>This meeting is 100% dedicated to the community.</li> </ol>
Hector Ramirez explained to the subcommittee that the roles of the UsCC and SAAC subcommittees are equally important.
B. Theater and Comic Book Projects: Mirtala Parada Ward and Dr. Luis Guzman attended the Theater project on Sunday. There were more than 100 people in attendance. There are 14 more plays scheduled. There will not be a play for the month of December. It will start back up in January 2020.
The comic book is almost done. They are on step three. It will be completed by March 30, 2020. Fourteen youths participated in the project. Mirtala suggested that the subcommittee use some of their 2020 money to make extra copies of the comic book and also make copies in Spanish.
The comic book should be done by the end of February or early March. There will be a ceremony, judges will pick first, second and third place. They will be judged on comic book writing and how well they included mental health issues of Latino youth in their comic.

<ul> <li>Mirtala Parada Ward asked the subcommittee who would like to be the new Co-Chair. The department is working on giving a stipend of \$125 dollars a month for transportation or any necessities needed to attend the subcommittee meetings.</li> <li>Hector Ramirez was voted to be a new Co-Chair. Paco Retana will no longer be Co-Chair. We are looking for a couple of new Co-Chairs. If you are interested or want to nominate someone send an email to Dr. Luis Guzmán.</li> </ul>
