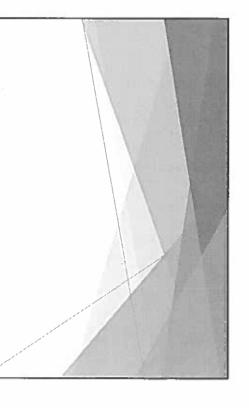

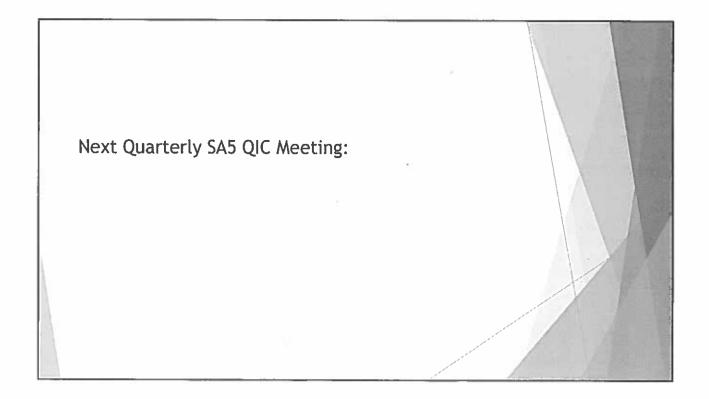

	Participants were asked to review the Minutes and Trouble Shooter and email updates/corrections to QIC Chair.			
DMH Updates	Jacquie Wilcoxen provided SA5 and DMH updates: 1) SA5 providers are doing "wonderful and inspiring work" during the Covid-19 crisis. DMH advises that they contact everyone on their caseloads in order to make sure clients' needs are being met. 2) The ACCESS Center is now offering a help line where community members can receive emotional support during the pandemic. 2) The SA5 Service Area Leadership Team (SALT) meeting is scheduled today at 3pm via Skype. The agenda will focus on homeless outreach and the housing crisis. 3) May is Mental Health Awareness Month to promote awareness and reduce stigma. Providers are encouraged to participate in We Rise virtual events. 4) Jacquie indicated that delivering services via telehealth is something that is likely "here to stay". 5) Lastly, State and County revenues are down but demand for services is up. 	Covid-19 Emergency Enrollment 1135 Waiver Medi-Cal Certification Bulletin, No. 20-01, May 11, 2020 Renee Lee, SA5 Medi-Cal Certification Liaison, told providers that on-site reviews and fire clearances have been temporarily suspended for SMHS provider sites due to the Covid-19 crisis. Instead, a desk review for certifications and re-certifications will be conducted. Upon conclusion of the Waiver period, the Medi-Cal Certification Liaison will follow-up with the provider to complete certification requirements. Providers will have 180 days to conduct the on-site review and submit the fire clearance and any outstanding paperwork.		Renee Lee, Ph.D. Providers

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Quality Assurance	 QA Knowledge Assessment Survey – Update Marc Borkheim, Ph.D. (QA Liaison) stated that the Knowledge Assessment Surveys are currently suspended due to Covid-19 and job duty reassignments within QA. He continues to recommends that providers organize their workflows to go over the previous two surveys with staff members. The survey contents are based on common misconceptions and thus can help providers reduce errors related to documentation. The next Knowledge Assessment Survey will likely be released in September. Network Adequacy / Access to Care Providers were asked to adhere to all of the Access to Care 		QA Division Providers
Quality Improvement	 and Network Adequacy guidelines as these have not changed as a result of Covid-19. Consumer Perception Survey (June 22 – 26, 2020) Jen Regan, Ph.D. (QI Liaison) provided information about the 		QI Division Providers
	upcoming CPS. The State moved the Spring 2020 survey period from May to June due to Covid-19. QI is developing work plans for survey administration. Consumers treated via telehealth will be provided an electronic link to fill out the survey. Paper surveys might also be an option for consumers seen face-to-face. Training webinars on CPS will be available to Providers in the coming weeks.		

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	ACCESS Center Test Calls The State requires that LACDMH continue to perform ACCESS Center Test Calls within LACDMH. QI elicited the Promotores program to provide test calls over the previous two months in order to take the pressure off service areas during Covid-19. SA5 was scheduled to do test calls in June, however, the Promotores will continue their role. If DMH is not able to locate a Farsi-speaking volunteer, however, a request will be made to our SA5 QIC members to initiate those calls. Jen Regan pointed out that the Promotores are a very good fit to do the ACCESS Center Test Calls given their deep connections with consumers and the community. Clinical and Nonclinical PIPS Jen Regan (QI Liaison) provided information regarding the current Clinical PIP focused on quality of care for consumers who have co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders. Substance abuse counselors working in Directly Operated clinics were training on Seeking Safety and enrolled in a UCLA Extension Course focused on mental health treatment. QI is evaluating the PIP and are hoping to disseminate "best practices" at some point in the future. The Nonclinical PIP is focused on issues related to Access to Care utilizing data from the NACT. More recently, this PIP is looking at the impact of Covid-19 and increases in telehealth with regards to their impact on consumer access to care.		Providers
