	The Department of Public Health Speaker; Kenia Fuentes Health Educator Re: CORONAVIRUS, Update on new guidance
	The Department is doing its best to keep us informed. There will be a Media Toolkit link for help with protection from evictions and electricity turn off.
	 COVID-10 Symptoms: Very similar to a Cold or Flu. High Fever, Coughing and difficult breathing, lower repertory symptomatic.
	 Everyone MUST protect themselves, especially Older Adults 65 years of age and older and pregnant woman.

Mirtala Parada Ward with DMH Updates:

The department is working aggressively at making sure that our community is safe and also our workforce is also safe. I just received instructions on our Telework requirements.

- ❖ All County facilities are closed to the public, are workforce is still working, we just received direction on how the Telework structure will be done across the department. We are going to be having skeleton crews, all programs, all clinics will have staff but not their usual staff, 50% of the staff will be rotated, this also applies with the UsCC unit, we will have staff but limited staff. One half of our staff will be working from home and the other staff will be working at our office.
- Clinical prospective Operation: all clinics will be closed. We are developing a process for Tele-Psychiatry (Consultation with a Psychiatrist by phone). So clients can have contact with their psychiatrist and case workers over the phone.
- ❖ Right now, the Medi-cal regulations are you can only get a 1-month subscription for your medication. We are working right now to see if we can change that to a 3-month supply, so that they don't have to be out in the community and be exposed to the virus.
- Our department is under Heath Services umbrella. Triage system protocols have been developed. Services will be limited but we are developing a platform to give help to the community. As a Health Care Provider, we are working very aggressively to make sure we provide services, and those services require minimal contact. To make sure our community and our staff are protected.

Wellness Center - Paco Retana:

The Wellness Center continues to serve the community. We are folding out a Town Home policies to make sure we are providing the community's needs. We will be open regular business hours, 50% of staff are working from home and the other 50% are working at Wellness Center. Keeping the Social Distancing in mind.

To reduce anxieties and keep in touch with Family & Friends

- ➤ Check in with Family and Friends, by making a phone call to them, you can also FaceTime/Duo/Skype with them. Also with our children we can make a Coping skills booklet, they can list the copping skills they been practicing like; listening to music, playing game boards and going outside to ride their bikes. Limit the amount of news the watch.
- ➤ OSK & ALPHA Studios LAUSD will open up Board District 2 Grab & Go food centers. Wednesday March 18,2020 from 7:00am 10:00am.

Capacity Building Projects:

	 Theater Play; All LA County Mental Health has cancelled County events, will be cancelled till the end of March 2020. We had 3 events booked for this month 3/27, 3/28 and 3/29. I contacted all 3 venues and postponed plays until further notice. Now we are just waiting for some direction because we have 2 more plays scheduled for April. Comic Book: Workshops ended last year in November 2019 and the Cover design contest also was done in December last year in 2019. In January the design work was being conducted for the final deliverables for the comic book anthology and was sent to print and the release party was February 29, 2020 at the Vernon branch library where the comic book workshops were hosted. IMCES – Lucy We are receiving funding for a program to detect early signs of Psychosis and prevent full blown episodes. If you hear of a friend, family member or any youth that seems disoriented or disorganized thought process. They can get an assessment done to see if they qualify for these services.
